One of the most popular holidays in LA is Cinco Mayo, Mexico's Independence Day

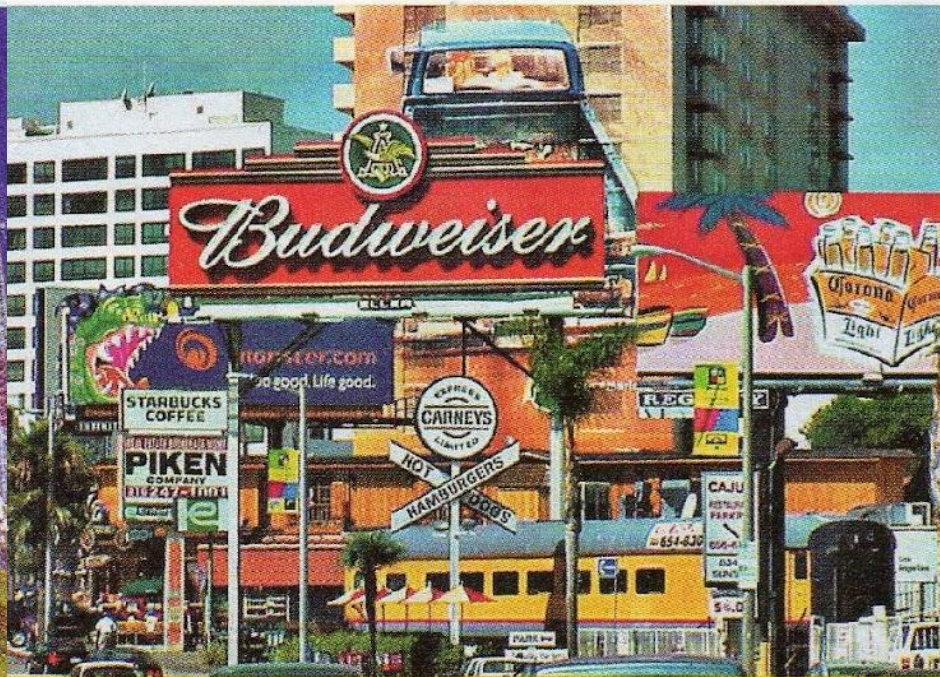
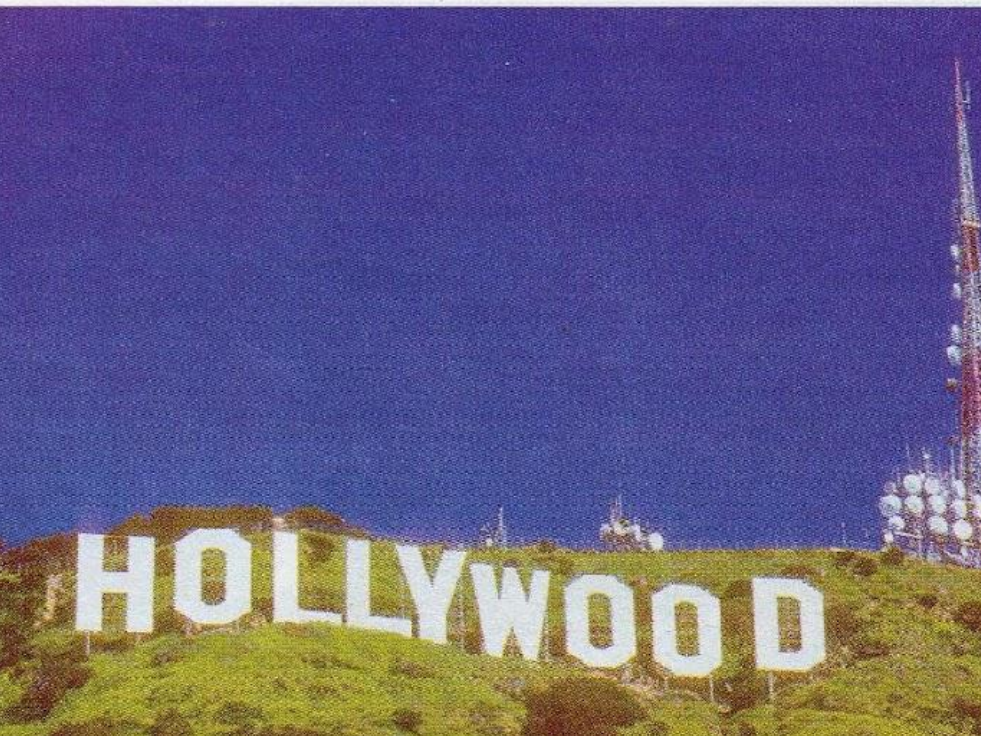

Hollywood Boulevard as taken from the Kodak Theatre (the place where the Oscar nights take place)

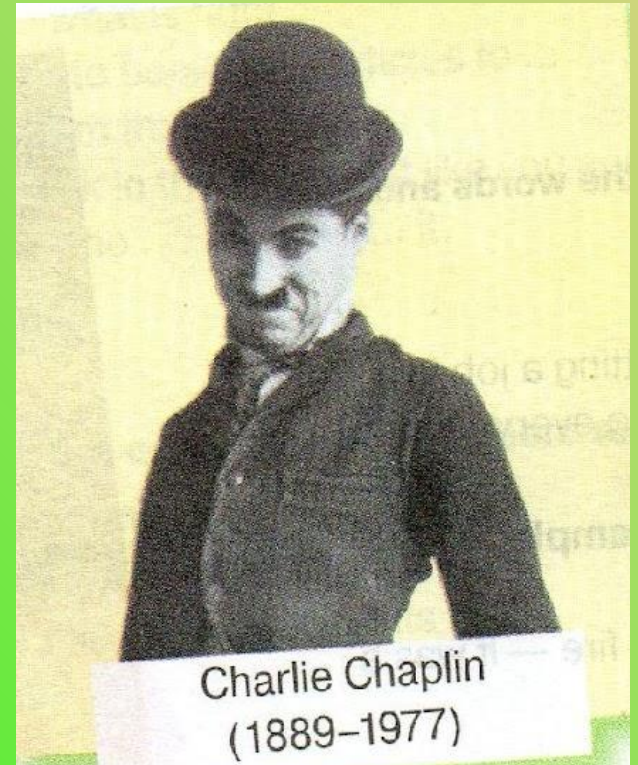
Hollywood

- Hollywood is still the centre of American film industry, though many studios have moved out of it.
- The famous Hollywood sign is known all over the world. Each letter in the sign is 15.5 m tall. In 1932, during the Great Depression, one young actress, Peg Entwistle, even jumped to her death from the sign's giant letter "H".

Los Angeles has been a lot of things over the past 100 years.

- First, it was a little city with orange forest and great weather. But, one day in 1908 a group of people from Chicago came to Los Angeles to shoot a film.
- In the 1920s Hollywood made 80% of the world's films.

Silent and black-and-white films of those early years starring Mary Pickford and Charlie Chaplin were forced out by sound films in the middle of the 1920s.



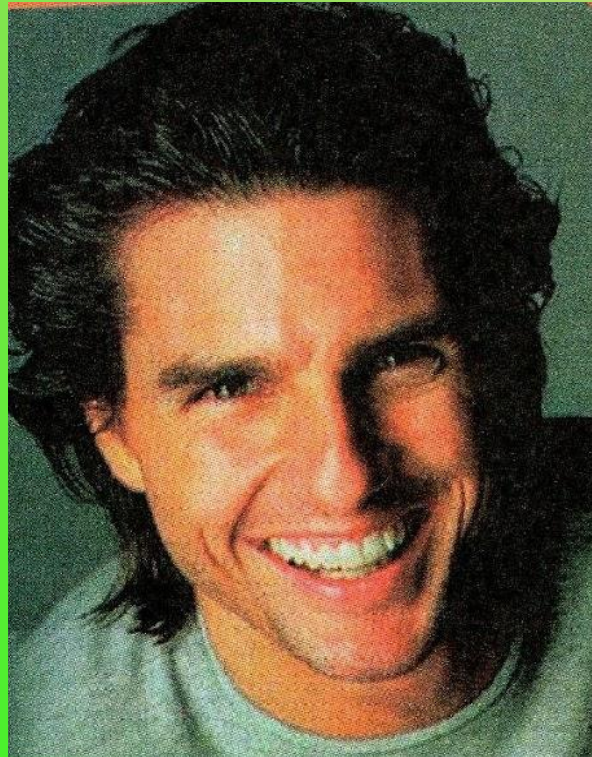
- The first colour film “Gone with the Wind”, was shot in 1939. This film brought a great success to Vivien Leigh and Clark Gable who starred in the film.



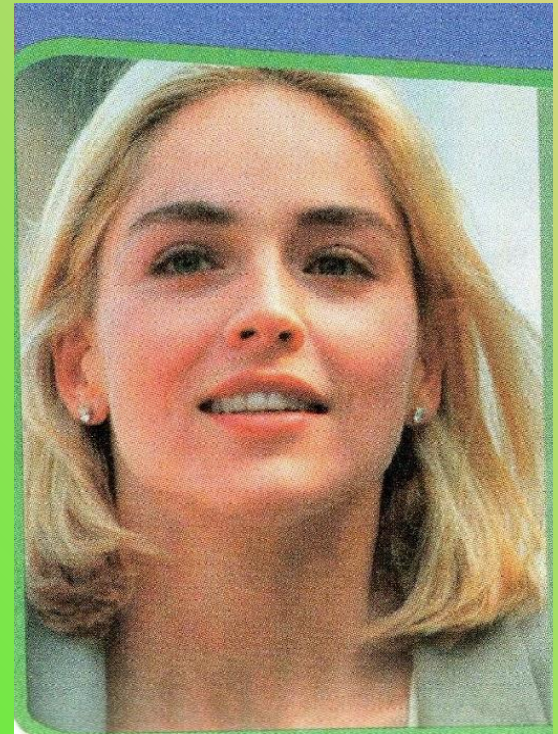

The famous Mann's Chinese Theatre in Hollywood is where many of the big movies are premiered.

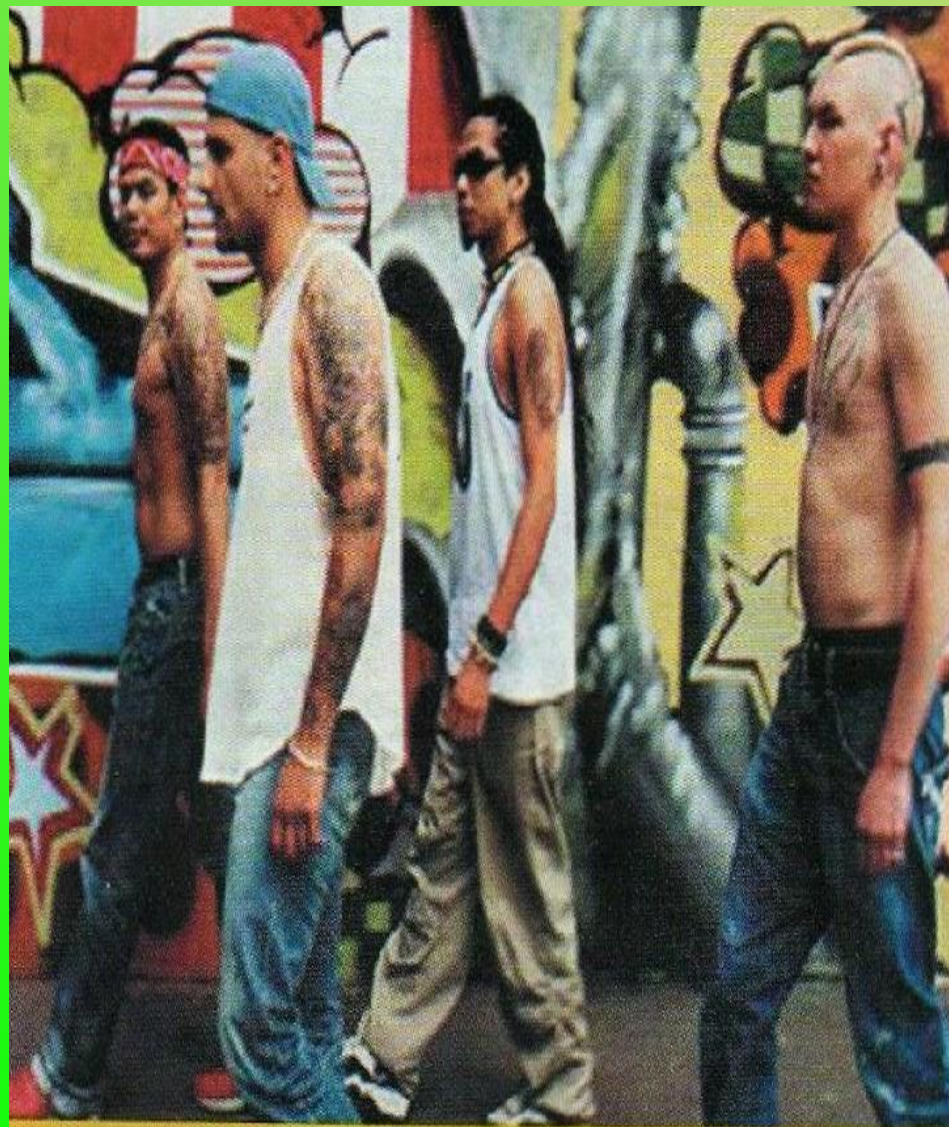

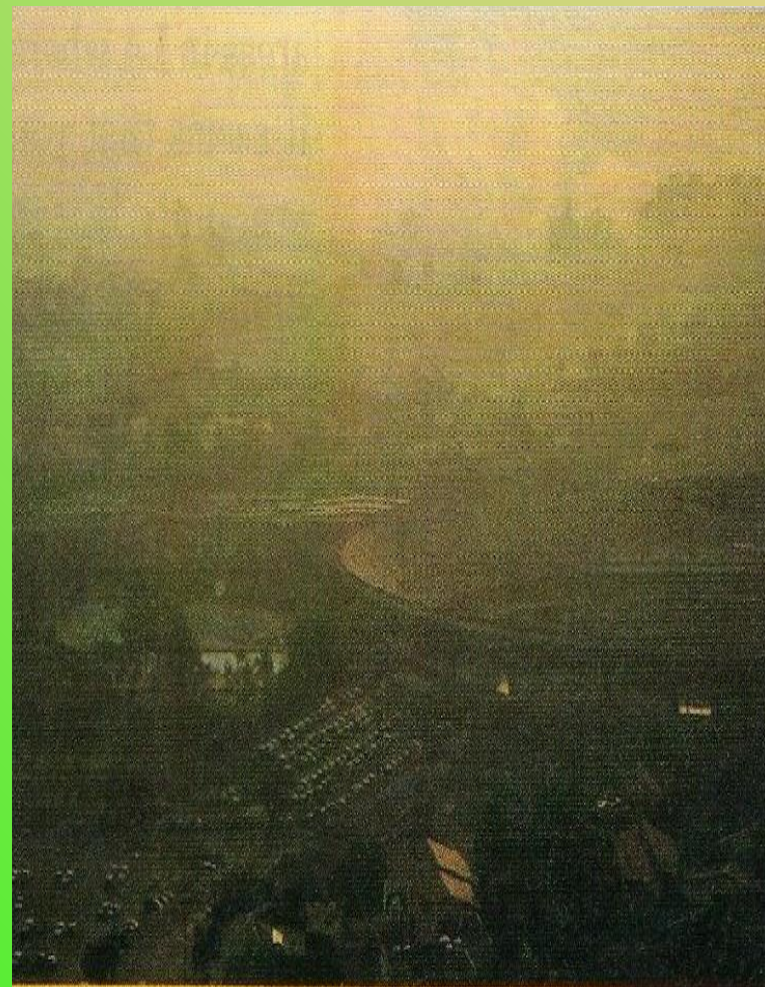


The entrance to the Universal Studios
