It is the sixth largest country by total area. It is the only country which is also a whole continent. However, the population is relatively small. The people of Australia are called **Australians**.

- Area -805 sq. km
- **Canberra** is the capital city of the Commonwealth of Australia.
- The city is located at the northern end of the Australian Capital Territory. As the seat of the government of Australia, Canberra is the site of **Parliament House**, the **High Court of Australia** and numerous government departments and agencies.
- It is also the location of many social and cultural institutions of national significance, such as **the National Gallery of Australia** and **the National Museum of Australia**.

Australia is on the other side of the world. In Australia hot winds blow from the North and cold winds blow from the South.

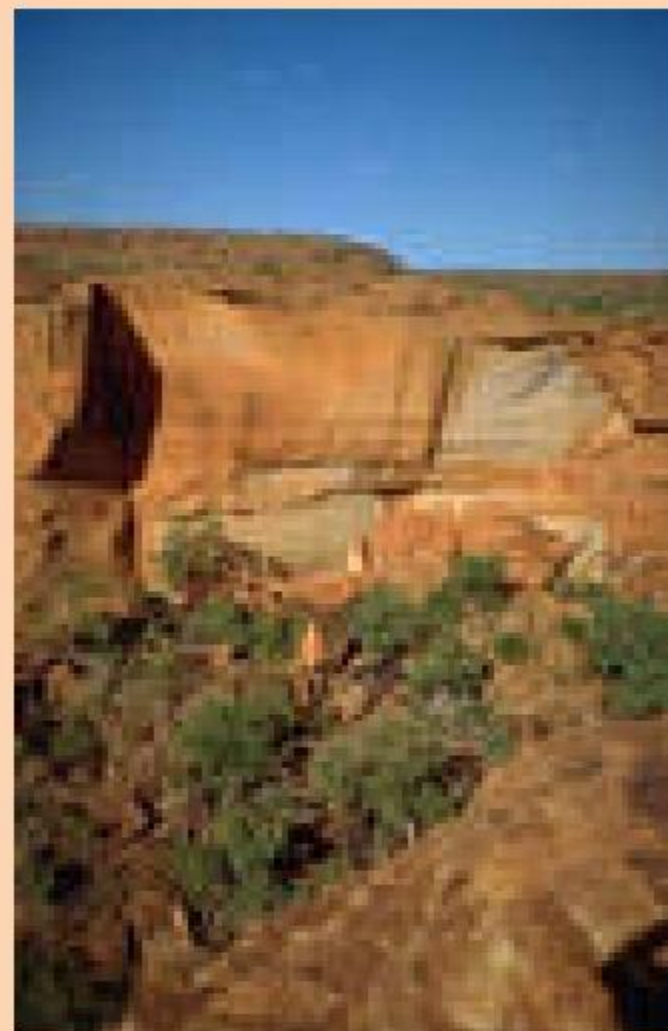
There are different climatic regions here. The climate ranges from tropical in the north to cool in the south-east.

There are such weather hardships as droughts, floods and cyclones. The continent suffers from the lack of fresh water. There is not much rain in many parts of the country and they are very dry.

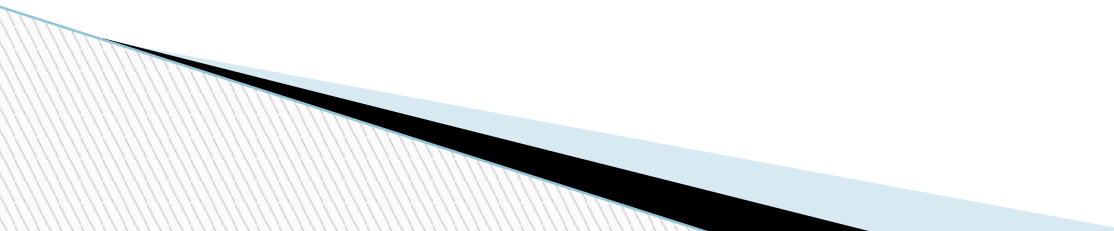


The Relief

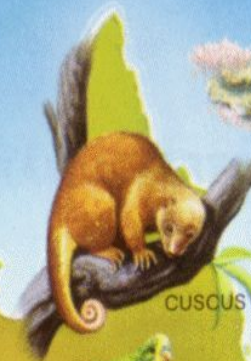

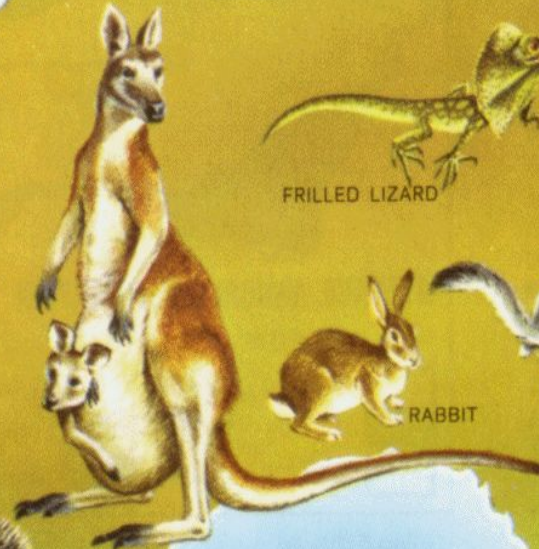

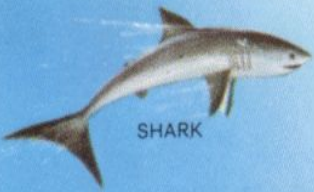

Kangaroos live in Australia.

Kangaroos can't walk and run, but they can jump very fast - 30 km



Baby kangaroos are very small - only 3 centimetres long. They can see when they are 9 weeks old and they can jump when they are 8 months old.



Koala



- The koala is one of the best known and most loved animals in Australia. Koalas live in lightly wooded areas containing suitable food.



AUSTRALIAN DINGO



The Dingo is Australia's wild dog.

Dingoes are an introduced species - opinions on when the Dingo came to Australia vary greatly, and range from 15,000 to 2,000 years ago. Dingoes are found on the mainland of Australia but about a third of all wild Dingoes in the south east of the continent are

Dingo/domestic dog crosses. The Dingo normally weighs between 10kg and 24kg, they stand between 44cm and 63cm high to the shoulder.



Australian flora

- In the south east of Australia there are tropical forests of eucalyptus trees which never lose their leaves, even in winter.
- Some plants can not be found in other parts of the world.

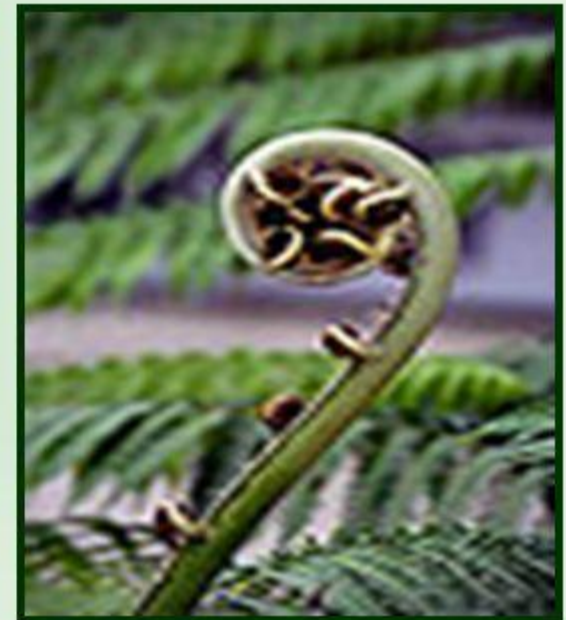
