KERKINITIDA




One of the first ancient Greek cities based on the Western coast of the Crimean Peninsula was Kerkinitida.

KALOS LIMEN




In the 4th century BC on the territory of the modern village of black sea was founded the ancient Greek city of Kalos Limen.

PANTICAPAEUM




In the first half of the 6th century BC in the Eastern part of the Crimea in the city of Kerch was founded the ancient Greek Polis Panticapaeum.

In the 1st century ad after the victory of the Roman army over the tavro-Scythian army, which kept the siege of Chersonesos, the Romans built a fortress-city of Haraks.

THE SCYTHIAN NAPLES



In the 3rd century BC on the South-Eastern coast of the Crimean Peninsula was founded the city of Naples-the capital of the late Scythian state.
