The Culture of Egypt.



- **The Culture of Egypt has six thousand years of recorded history. Ancient Egypt was among the earliest civilizations. For millennia, Egypt maintained a strikingly complex and stable culture that influenced later cultures of Europe, the Middle East and Africa.**

Seasonal business.

- Most ancient of Egyptians were farmers. Their houses were built of raw bricks to keep cool in the midday heat. Each home had a kitchen with an open roof. Floors were covered with reed mats and wooden chairs, beds and tables were furniture.



Appearance.

- Ancient Egyptians paid great importance to personal hygiene and appearance. Clothing was made from simple white-washed linen cuts, men and women of the upper classes wore wigs and jewelry.

- The architecture of ancient Egypt is known to us by the constructions of tombs, temples and palace complexes.
