BASE Jumping-is a dangerous kind of sports in which a special parachute is used for jumping from fixed objects.

B.A.S.E.

Building (здание)

Antenna (антенна)

Span (перекрытие,
пролет моста)

The Earth (земля)



During a fall, parachutists use airflow to stabilize, allowing them to take a correct body position before opening the parachute. When performing a base jump, the jumper falls at a lower speed, and is less likely to stabilize due to the air flow and can go into uncontrolled rotation. In BASE jumps from low heights, it is necessary to open the parachute within these few seconds. If the expansion occurs at the time of uncontrolled rotation or, when the jumper is not stabilized, there is a high risk of getting entangled in the lines and cause a complete failure of the parachute.



Bass Jumping Species:

- Pilot Chute Assist**

- Wrong way**-jumper flies forward back
- Wingsuit**-
jumping in a special suit that gives the body a wing shape
- Tard**-The main thing is to roll over and not fall into the dome.
