# **Types of houses**

- **British people live in a variety of different types of houses. There are detached and semi-detached houses, terraced houses, flats, council houses and bungalows. Many people live in detached and semi-detached houses in the suburbs or in villages. British people who live in or near town centres, on the other hand, tend to live in terraced houses.**

- **These houses are built in rows and are often close together and have few rooms. Many houses in British inner-city areas are blocks of flats. Some of these are homes to the wealthy; others are cheap council flats. British pensioners often live in bungalows in the suburbs or in villages. These are homes which have no stairs.**
