Adverbs



Adverb is a word that modifies a verb.

Adverbs of manner describe verbs. They show **how** someone does something. Adverbs usually go after verbs.



He walks **quickly**.
Он ходит быстро. (как? Каким образом?)

We form adverbs by adding **-ly** to the adjective

Careful -> careful**ly**, quick -> quick**ly**

• Прилагательные, оканчивающиеся на **-le** теряют **-e** и прибавляют **-y**

Simple**e** -> simple**y**

• Прилагательные, оканчивающиеся на согласную **+y** теряют **-y** и

прибавляют **-ily**

easy**y** -> easil**ily**

Adverbs of manner:

quickly, well, badly, slowly,
easily...

NOTE!

The verbs look, smell, sound, feel, taste take an adjective, not an adverb.




She looks happy (not happily).

We feel terrible (not terribly).



Degrees of Comparison

Adverbs form their comparative and Superlative forms the same way as adjectives.

A boy runs fast	A dog runs faster	A horse runs fastest

	Adverb	Comparative form	Superlative form
Short adverbs	soon	sooner	soonest
	early	earlier	earliest
Long adverbs	carefully	more carefully	most carefully
Irregular adverbs	bad	worse	worst
	well	better	best
	many/ much	more	most
	little	less	least
