Adverbs

Adverb is a word that modifies a verb.

Adverbs of manner describe verbs. They show how someone does something. Adverbs usually go after verbs.



He walks <u>guickly</u>. Он ходит быстро. (как? Каким образом?)

We form adverbs by adding -ly to the adjective

Careful -> carefully, quick -> quickly

•Прилагательные, оканчивающиеся на –le теряют –е и прибавляют –у Simple -> simply

•Прилагательные, оканчивающиеся на согласную +у теряют –у и прибавляют –ily easy -> easily

Adverbs of manner:


quickly, well, badly, slowly, easily...

NOTE!

The verbs look, smell, sound, feel, taste take an adjective, not an adverb.


She looks <u>happy</u> (not happily). We feel <u>terrible</u> (not terribly).





Degrees of Comparison

Adverbs form their comparative and Superlative forms the same way as adjectives.
