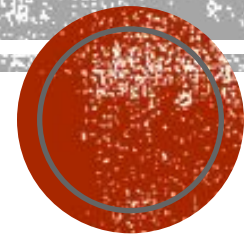

THE STORY ABOUT BEOWULF.**



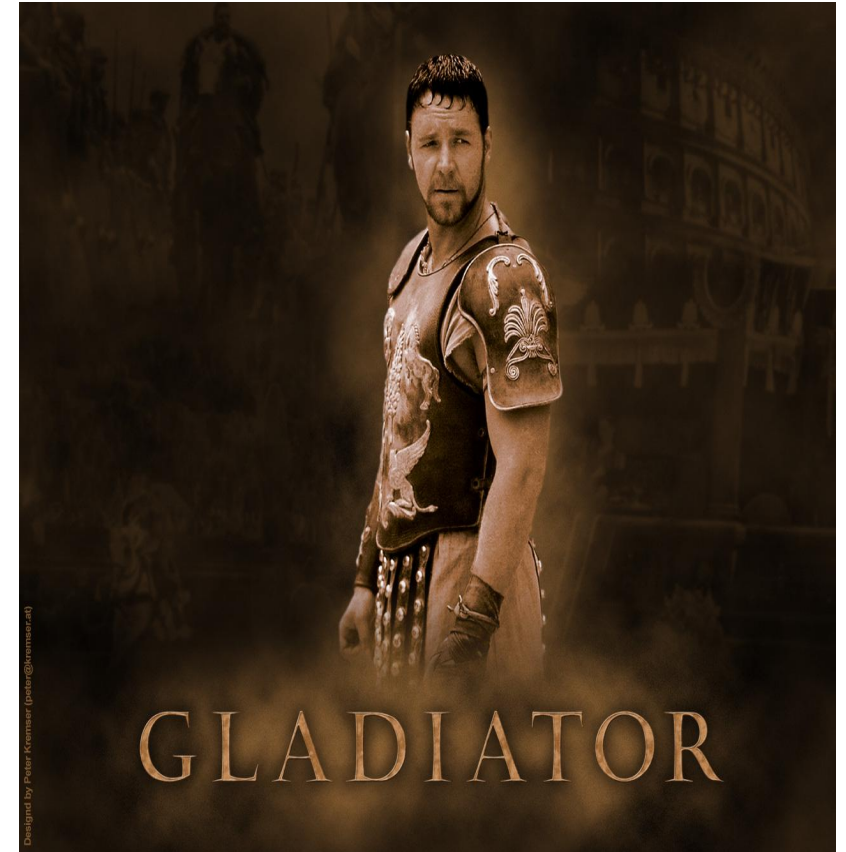
