We are bored.

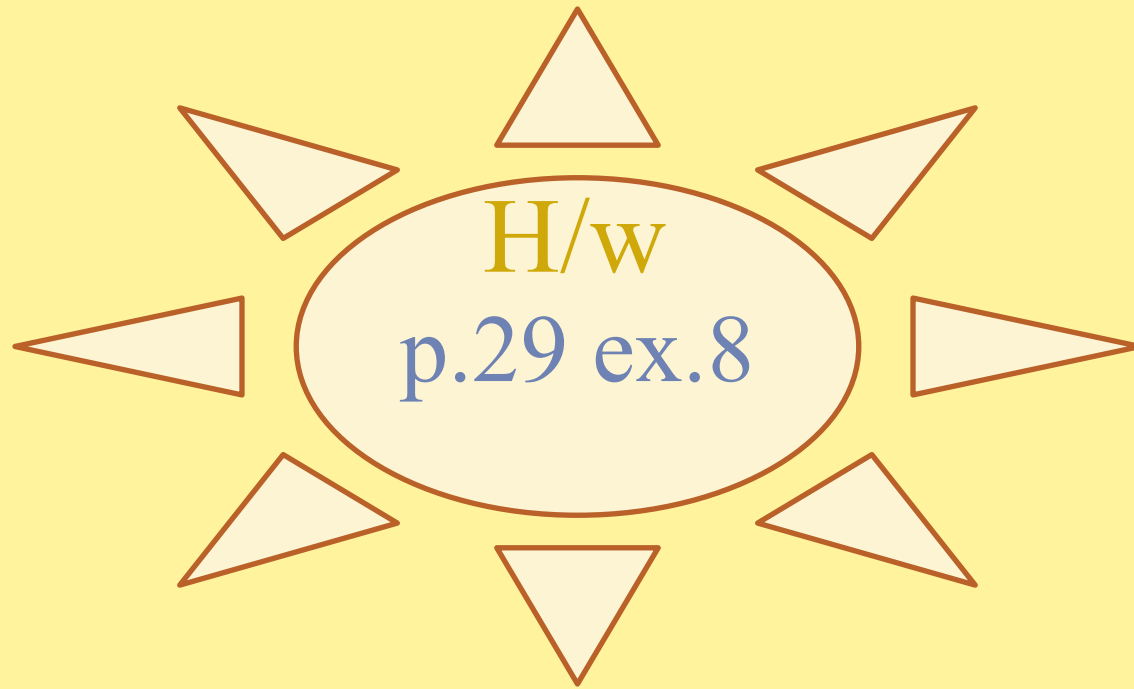
It was an exciting time. We all excited.
