Односложные прилагательные с долгим слогом образуют степени сравнения при помощи суффиксов –er, (the) -est.

При прибавлении суффиксов конечная –e опускается.

cold	colder	the coldest
nice	nicer	the nicest



Двусложные прилагательные ,оканчивающиеся на -ow, -er,-y,-ble,

образуют степени сравнения при помощи суффиксов –er, (the) -est .При этом буква –у меняется на і после согласной и не меняется после гласной
