*multimedia* — the combination of sound, graphics and video to present information on a **computer**

If + глагол в настоящем времени.

**Will** не употребляется после союза **if**.

2.If I **went** to London, I **would** be happy. (Настоящее и будущее время).

If + глагол в **прошедшем** времени). В главном предложении **would** + глагол в I форме.

3. If I **had gone** to London, I **would have** been happy. (Прошедшее время).

If + **had** + глагол в III форме. В главном предложении **would have** + глагол.
