

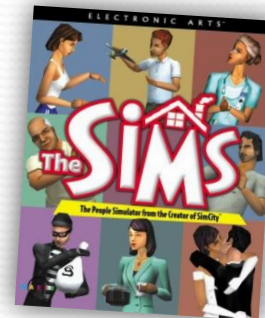

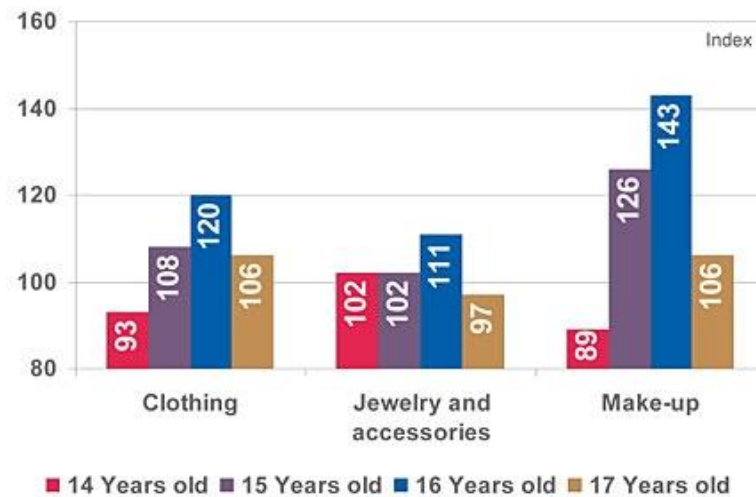


Britain Young Consumers
