

Употребляется для выражения самостоятельного действия объекта

- 1) Usually I feed my dog and than walk it.
- 2) When I was ill, my mother walked my dog.
- 3) I shall walk your dog tomorrow if you are busy.

Passive

Употребляется для выражения действия над объектом

- 1) Moscow is visited by millions of people every year.
- 2) Some researchers think that Moscow was founded much earlier than in the 12th century.

3) Several sports centers will be built in our city.

1. Употребляется для выражения действия над объектом (подлежащее испытывает на себе то или иное действие).

Passive Voice

2. Употребляется, когда действующее лицо либо неизвестно, либо оно нас не интересует.

This book was bought yesterday. – Эта книга была куплена вчера.
