Charles Babbage



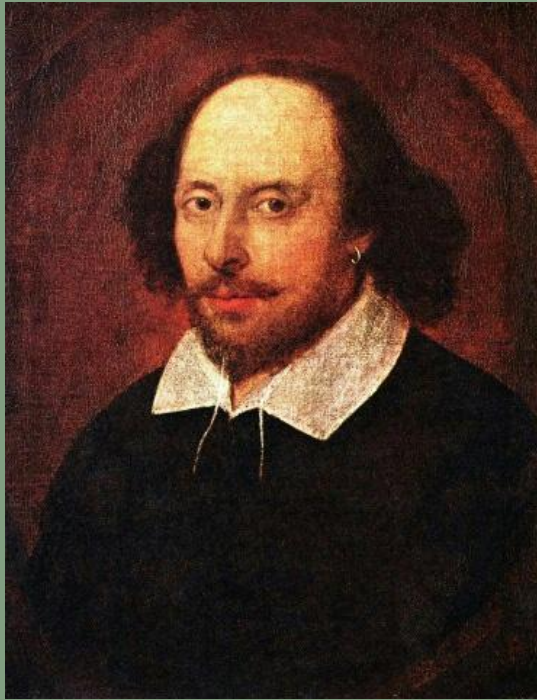
- ✓ Born: 26 December 1791

- ✓ Originated the idea of a programmable computer
- ✓ Died: 18 October 1871 (aged 79)

Alexander Graham Bell



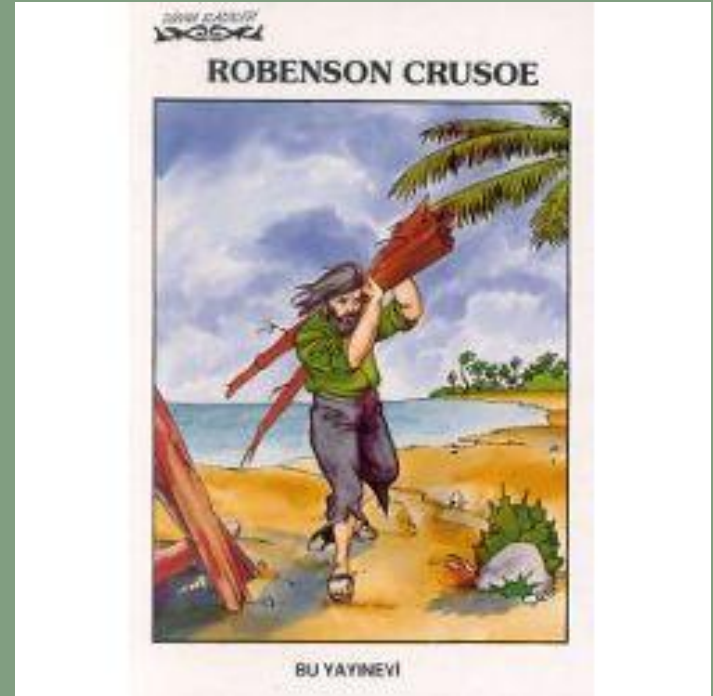
- ✓ Born: 3 March 1847

- ✓ associated with the invention of the telephone

William Shakespeare



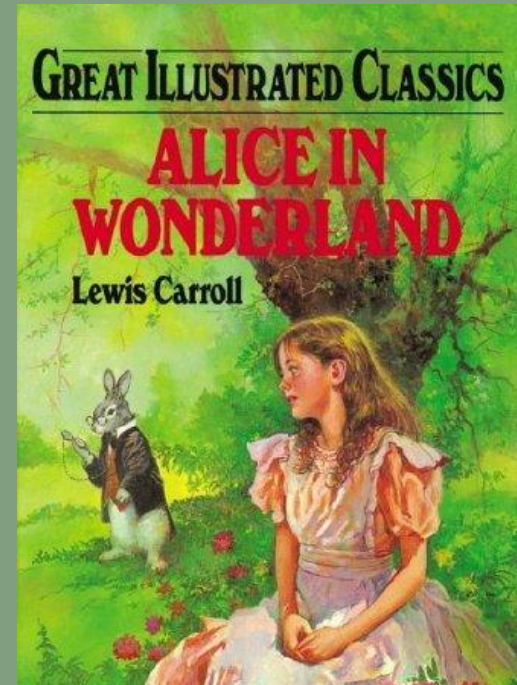
- ✓ Born: April 1564 (exact date unknown)

- ✓ 38 plays, 154 sonnets
- ✓ Died: 23 April 1616

- ✓ Born: 1659|1661(?)
- ✓ Occupation: writer, journalist, spy
- ✓ 500 books, pamphlets, journals
- ✓ Famous novel: "*Robinson Crusoe*"
- ✓ Topics: politics, crime, religion, psychology
- ✓ Died: 24 April 1771 (?)

Lewis Carroll



- ✓ Name: Charles Lutwidge Dodgson
- ✓ Born: 27 January 1832
- ✓ Occupation: writer, mathematician, clergyman, photographer
- ✓ Genre: literary nonsense
- ✓ Died: 14 January 1898

Sir Arthur Conan Doyle



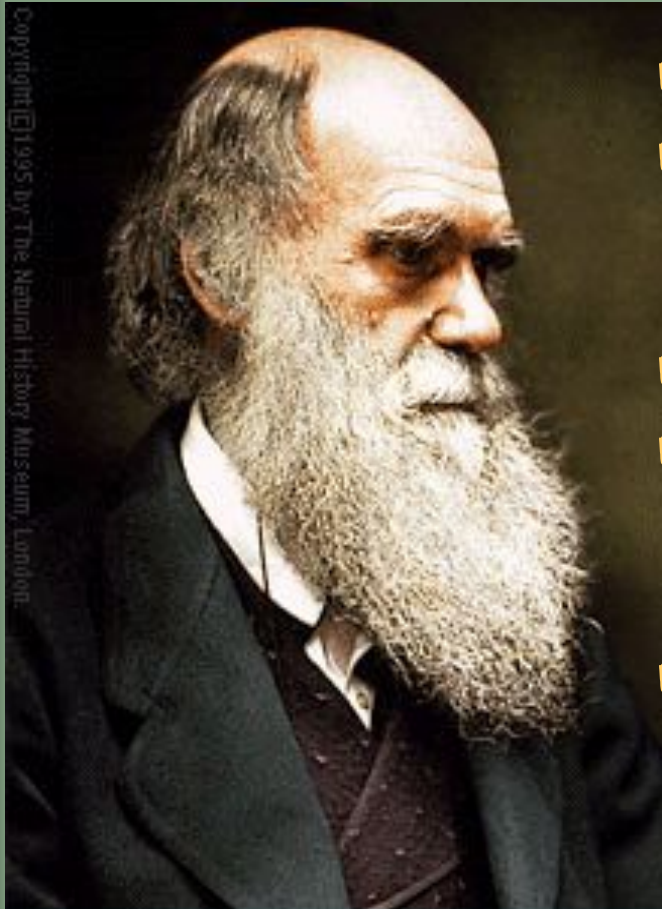
- ✓ Born: 22 May 1859

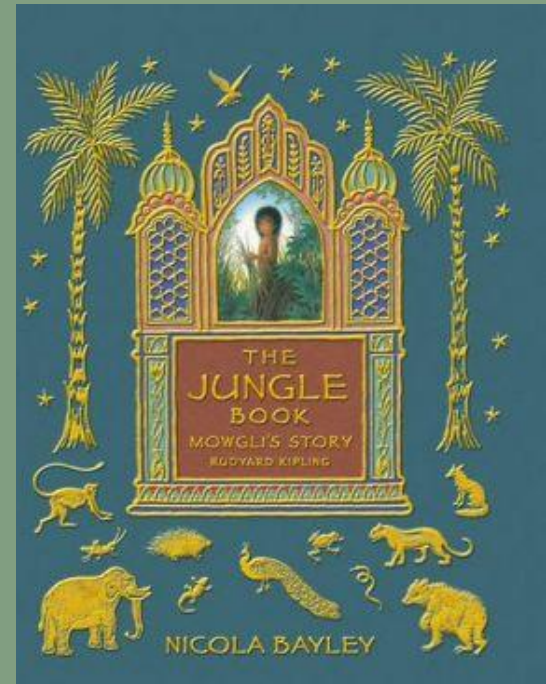
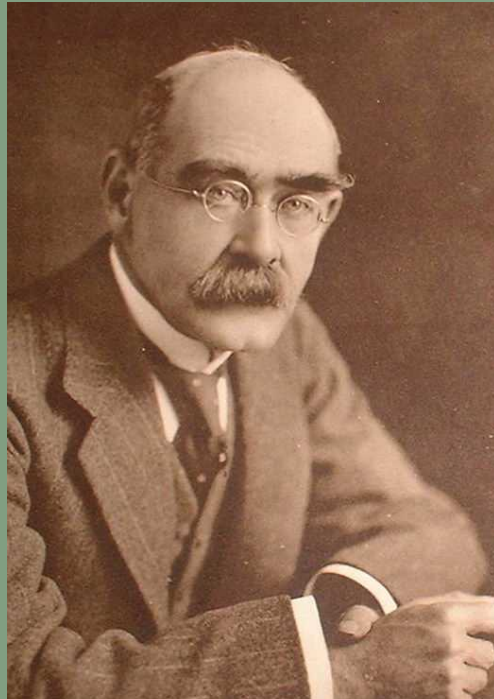
- ✓ Full Name: Charles Robert Darwin

Robert Louis Stevenson



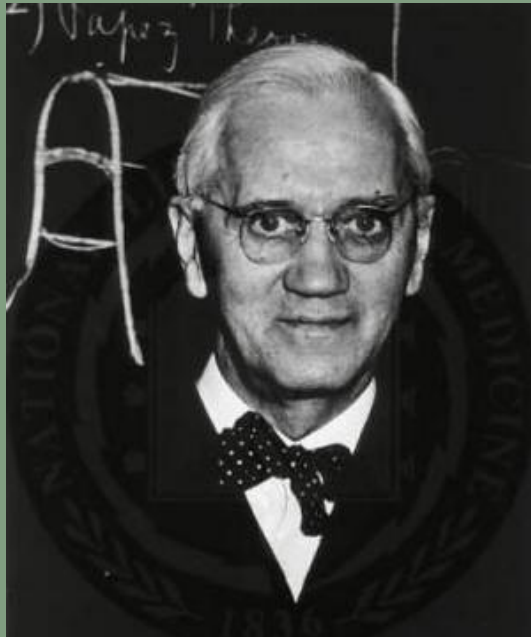
- ✓ Born: 13 November 1850

Charlie Chaplin



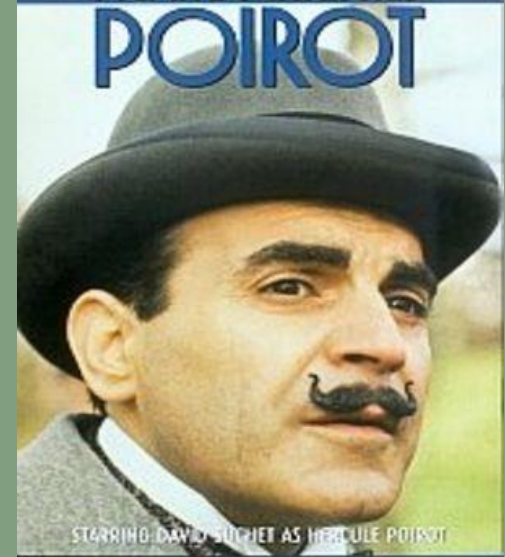
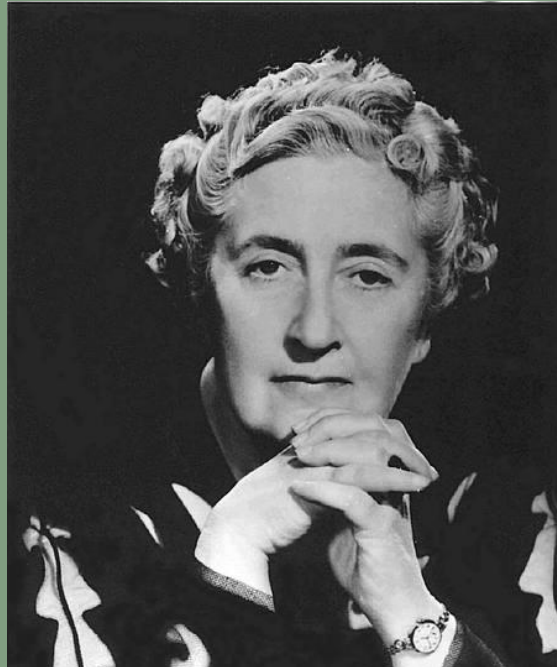
- ✓ Full Name: Sir Charles Spencer Chaplin

John Logie Baird



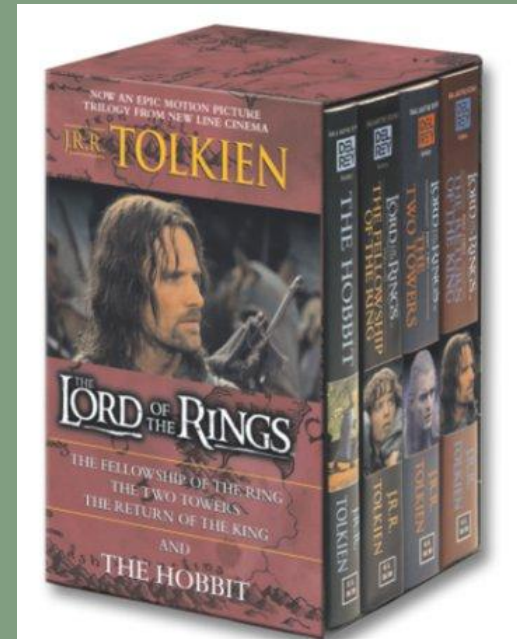
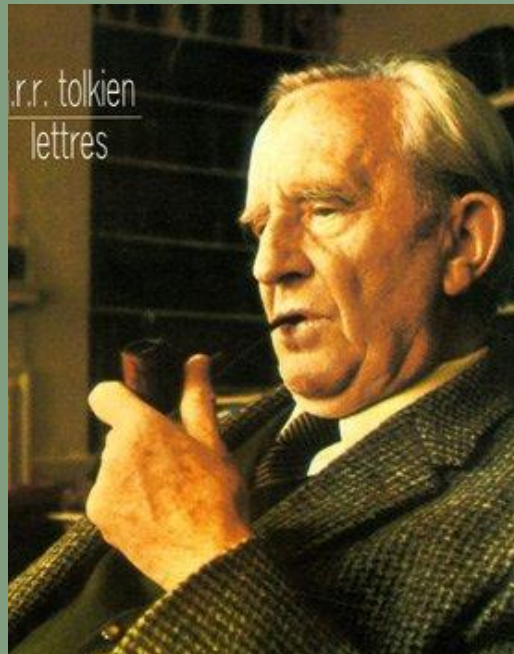
- ✓ Born: August 13, 1888

Agatha Christie



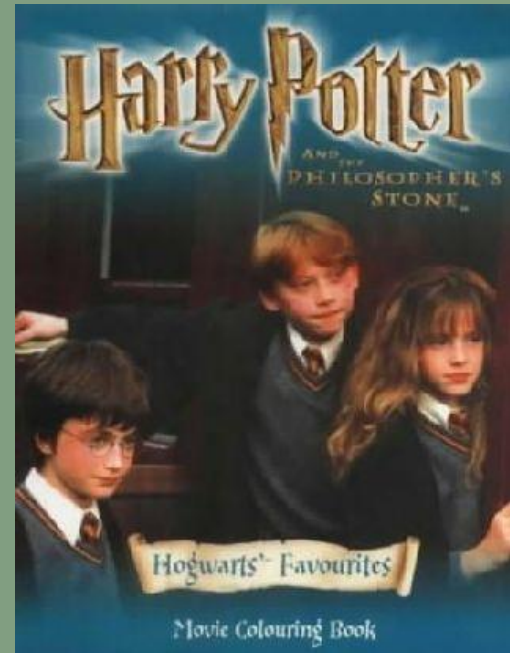
- ✓ Name: Agatha Mary Clarissa, Lady Mallowan
