


Territory and Population It is territory about 3 million square km. Population is only 1 million people.




Climate

The climate is sharply continental. Winters are extremely cold (down to -50-60C. In summer the sun doesn't set for many days.




The political system of the Sakha Republic




The Emblem and The National Flag

At present, concentrates of tin, stibium,gold, platinum, silver, rare metals, are exported from the republic abroad.




Traditions and Customs.

The Yakut people from the ancient times used milk, butter, meat and fish for their food.








