
# William the Conqueror 1028-1087

 When Robert of Normandy died in 1035 William inherited his father's title.


## In 1053 William married Matilda of Flanders, the daughter of Count Baldwin of Flanders.

#### William founded the United English Kingdom.





#### He created army and fleet.

#### The coins of William




