ГЛАГОЛ HAVE GOT/

HAS GOT

(иметь)

используется только в настоящем времени (Present Simple)

для выражения принадлежности

(когда нам нужно сказать, что у кого-то что-то есть)

I have got a sister.

He has got a sister.

REMEMBER!

have got *мы используем с местоимениями I, we, you, they*

has got *мы используем с местоимениями he, she, it*

we

you

they

have got

he

she

it

has got

Полная форма

Краткая форма

I have got two hands.

I've got two hands.

You have got a nose.

You've got a nose.

We have got a head.

We've got a head.

They have got brown hair.

They've got brown hair.

She has got a big mouth.

She's got a big mouth.

He has got blue eyes.

He's got blue eyes.

It has got a tail.

It's got a tail.

*Отрицательная форма образуется при помощи частицы **not**, которая следует за глаголом **have/has***

I have **not** got a sister.

He has **not** got a brother.

Образование отрицательной формы

I have **not** got a sister.

I have not = I haven't

В вопросах have/has ставится перед подлежащим:

Have you got a sister?

Has he got a sister?

ANSWER THE QUESTIONS:

- Have you got red hair?
- Have they got two heads?
- Have we got three legs?
- Has he got a blue nose?
- Has a dog got a tail?
- Have you got purple eyes?
- Have people got white teeth?
- Have you got black mouth?



Образование общего вопроса

Has **He** **has got** a sister?

Yes, he **has**.

No, he **hasn't**.
