they eat. At last they find out that it is only eight o'clock after all. Mary is relieved. Children in Britain start school at the age of five (sometimes younger).

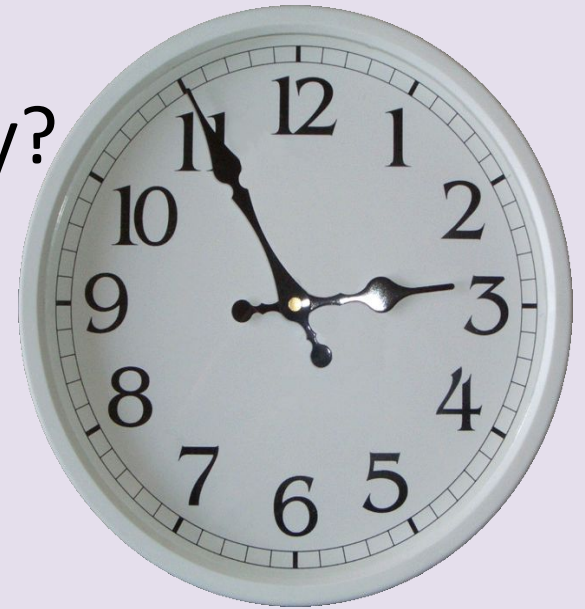
They start secondary school at the age of eleven.
