

Great Britain is not a large country. It is smaller than France or Norway. Its population is nearly 60 million people. The official language is English.




































London. The Thames.




London is situated on the river Thames. It is a big port. The Thames is not a long river. The English people call it "The Father of London". London began on the Thames.

The Houses of Parliament are the seat of the British government.


It is a very large building with beautiful towers.

The Clock Tower is 318 feet high.












It is one of the biggest zoos in the world.








and many birds at the zoo.







## Westminster Abbey

It is a royal church.






#### It is the London home of the Queen

To the sounds of music the guardsmen in their traditional bearskins arrive and give the palace keys to another group. British Queen was born on the 21- st of April, 1926.




Queen Elizabeth II

She ascended to the throne on the 6-th of February, 1953.


