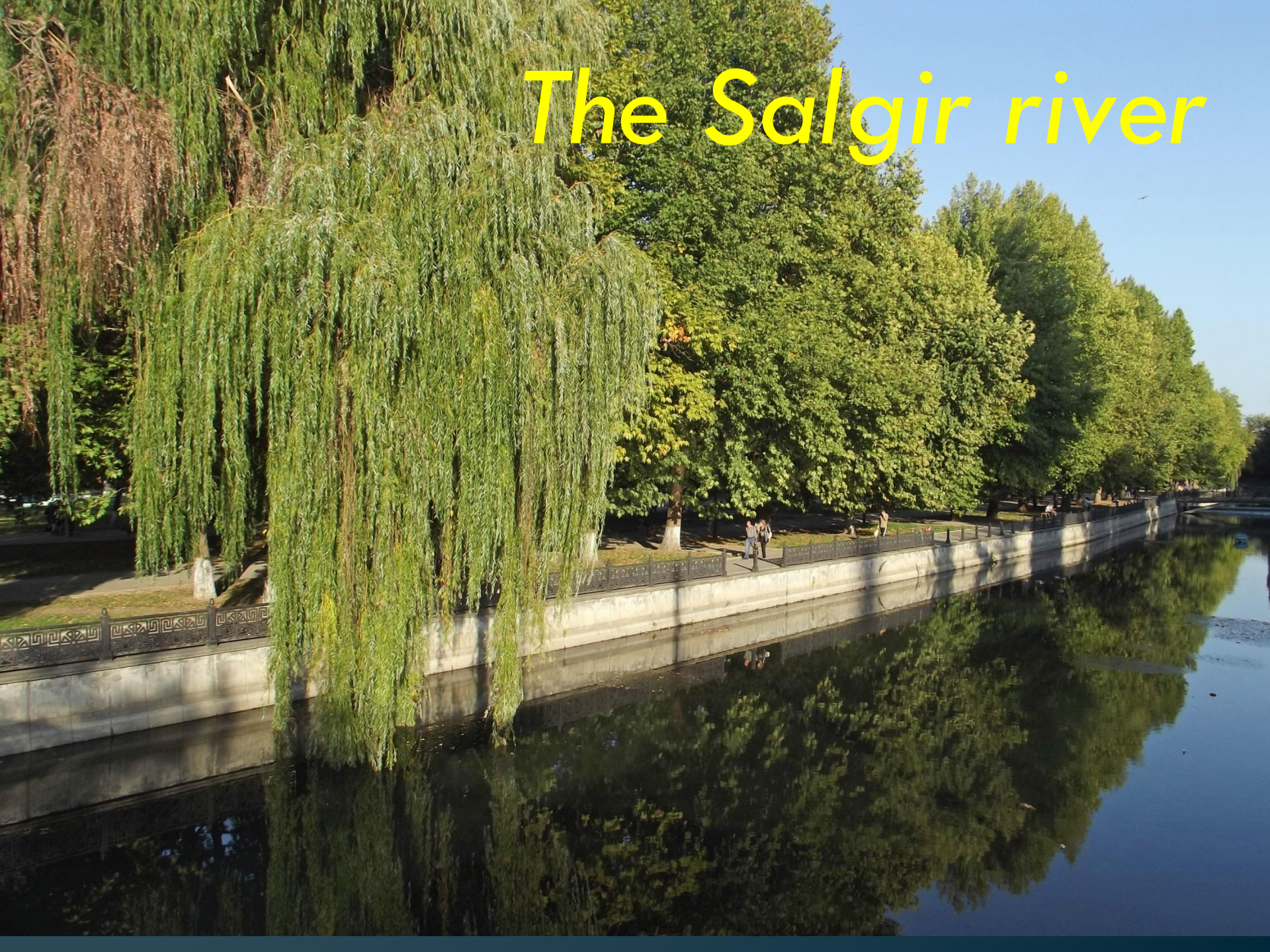


The Salgir river
