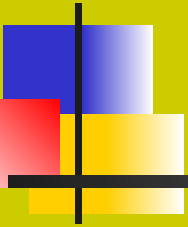


Grammar discoveries: Present Perfect or Past Simple

 - Make-made-made
 - Write-wrote-written
 - Ride-rode-ridden
 - Swim-swam-swum
 - Play-played-played
 - Jump-jumped-jumped
 - wash-washed-washed
 - Cut-cut-cut
 - Say-said-said
 - Go-went-gone
 - Run-ran-run
