

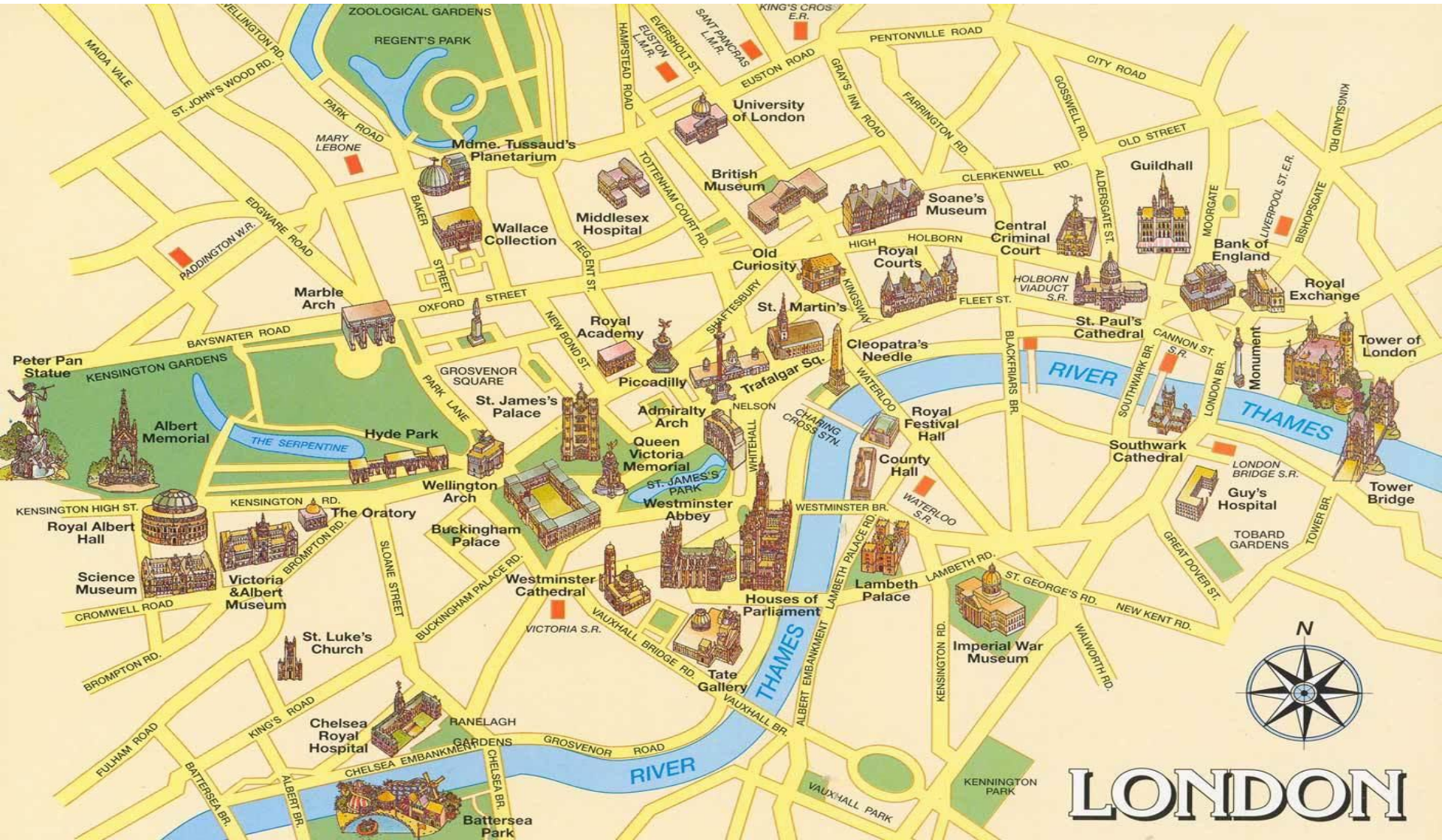
**WELCOME TO LONDON!**

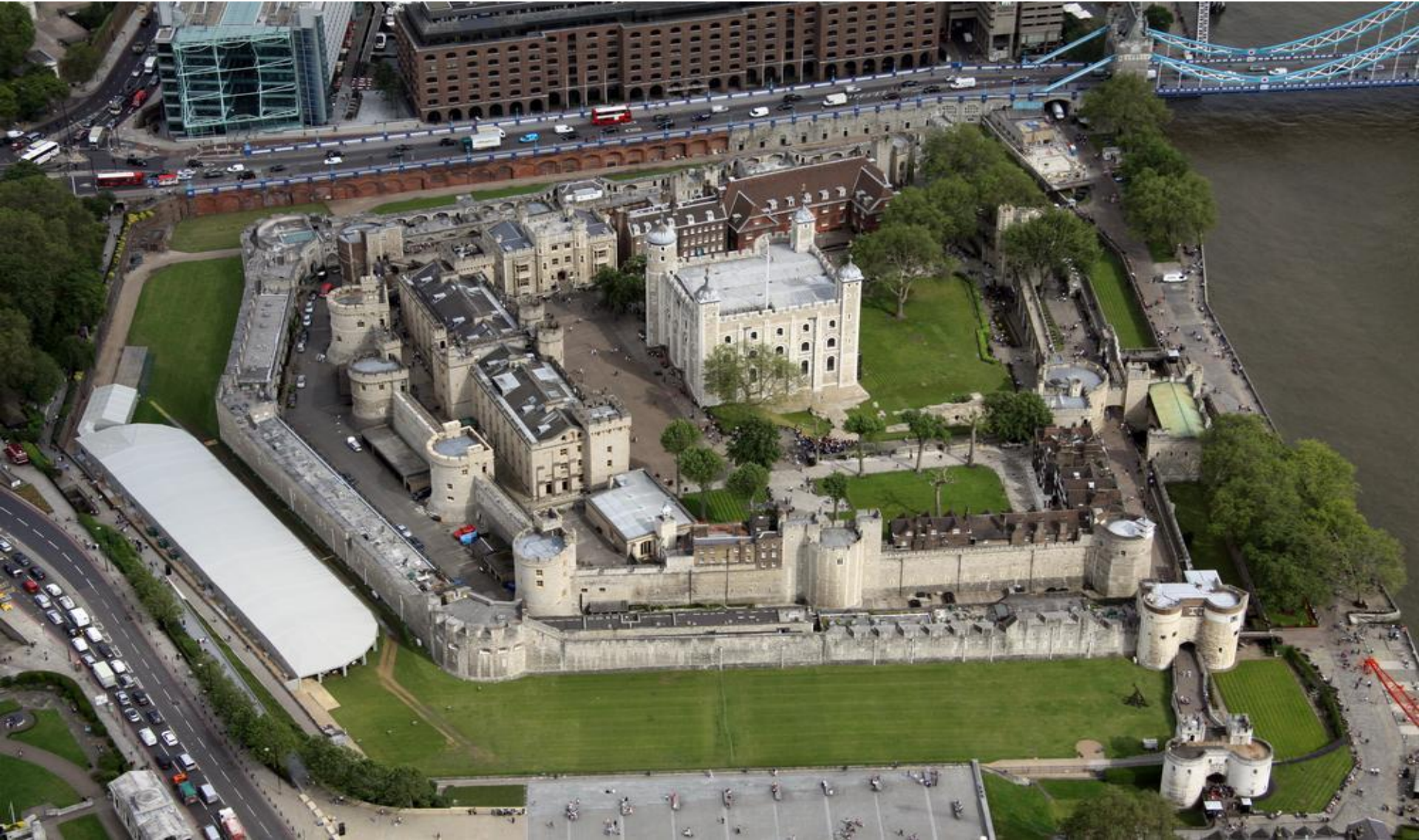
It was built in the 17<sup>th</sup> century by Sir Christopher Wren

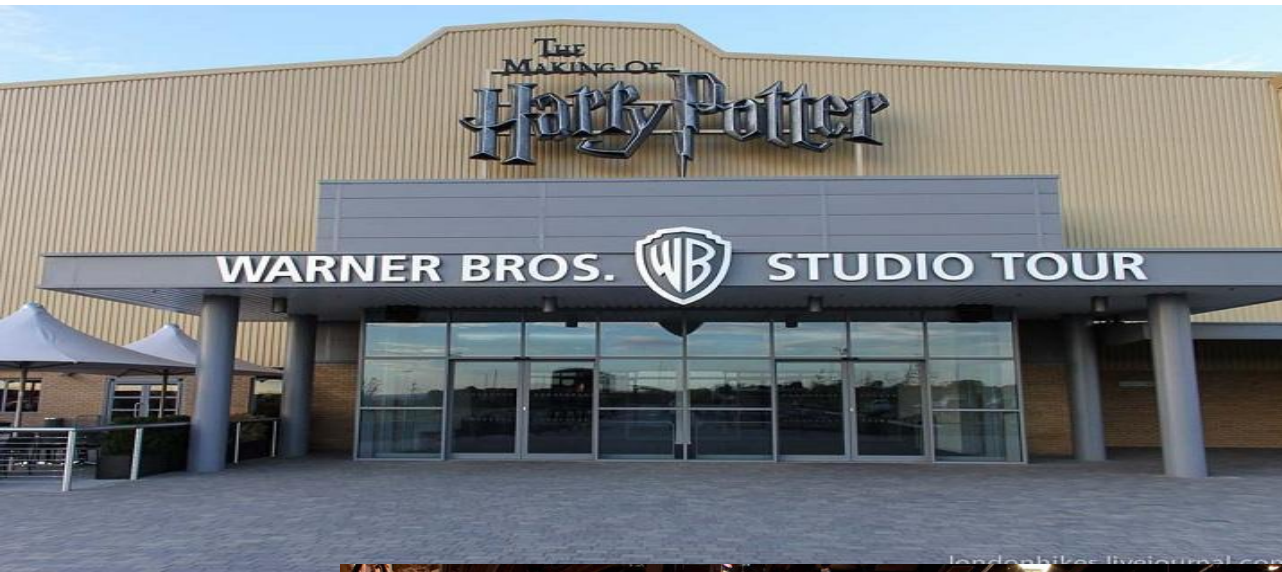
