

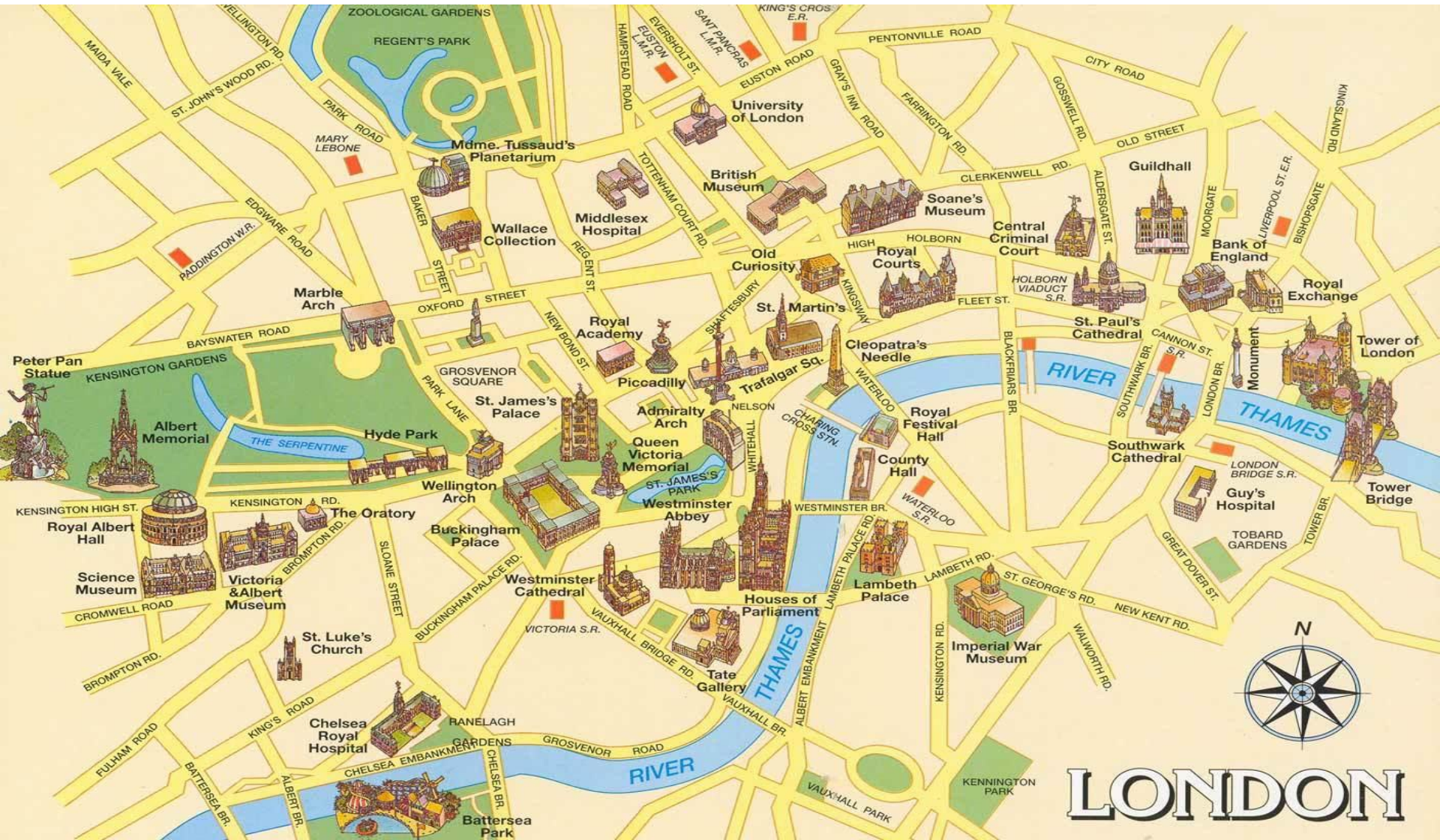
WELCOME TO LONDON!
