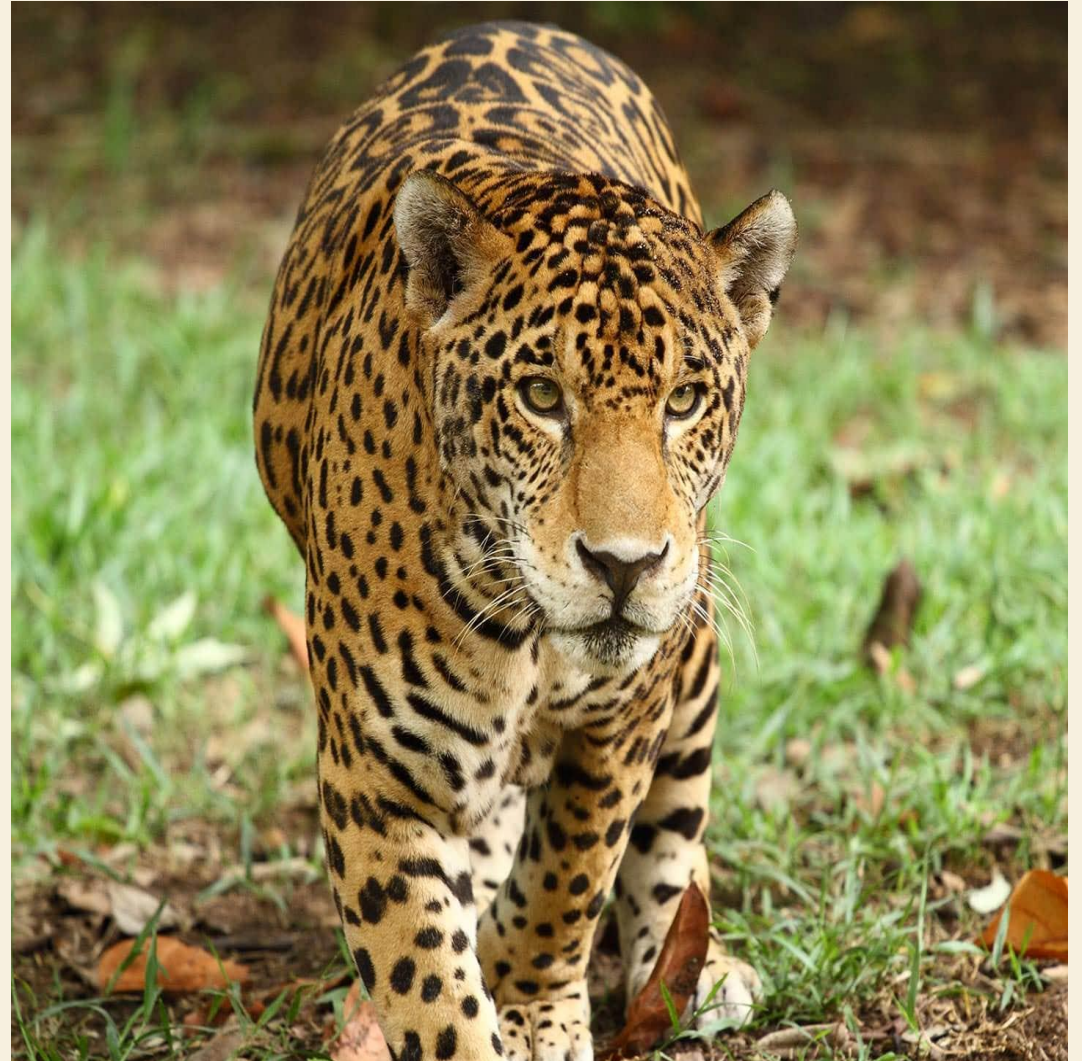
**NOW MEXICO HAS SEVERAL THOUSAND
