powder, drops, and mixture - medicine for treatment flu

to take a scalding footbath - to have a very hot bath for feet

Defining medical specialists

Veterinarian - a doctor who treats animals

surgeon - a doctor who operates on people with different diseases

Dentist - a doctor who treats teeth

Otolaryngologist - a doctor who treats ears, throat and nose

Therapeutics physician- a doctor who examines people

eye specialist - a doctor who treats eyes
