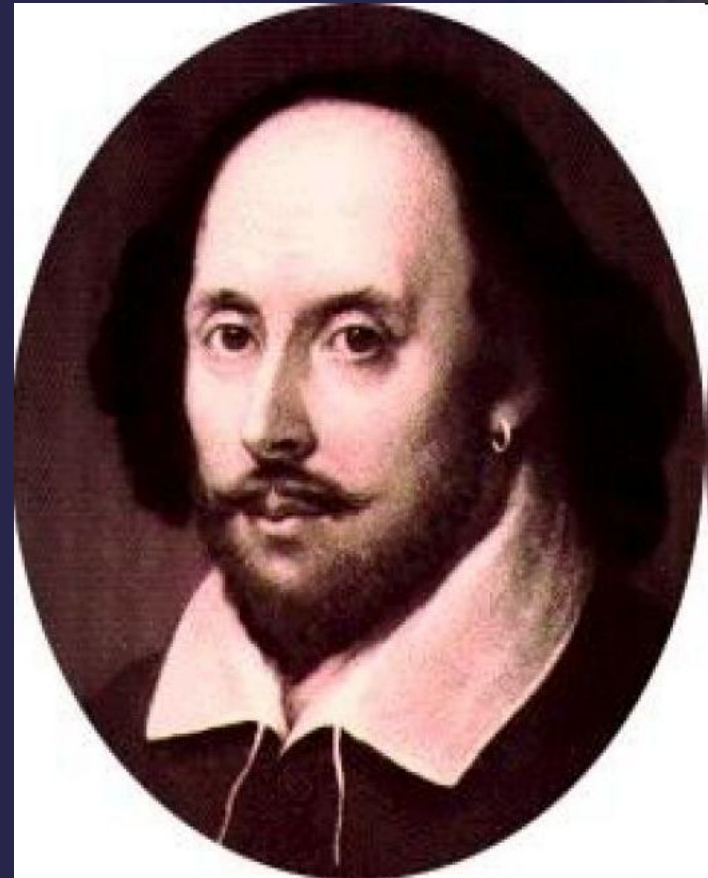

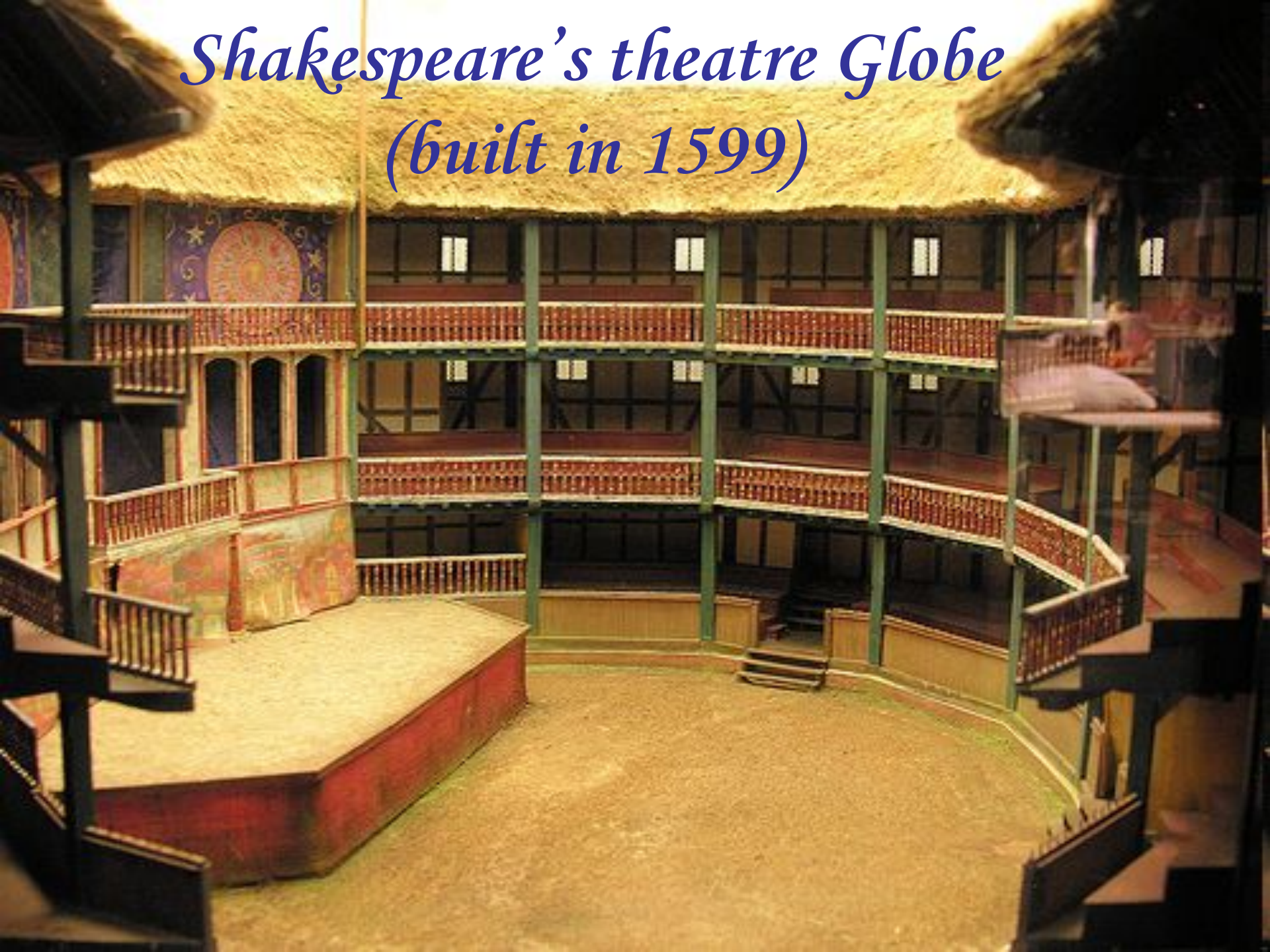


Elizabethan era



- In the Elizabethan era there was a huge demand for new entertainment. W.Shakespeare wrote at least 37 plays, although only 18 of them were published in his lifetime. A play could be used as vehicle for propaganda and could lead to the Tower of London.

(built in 1599)*

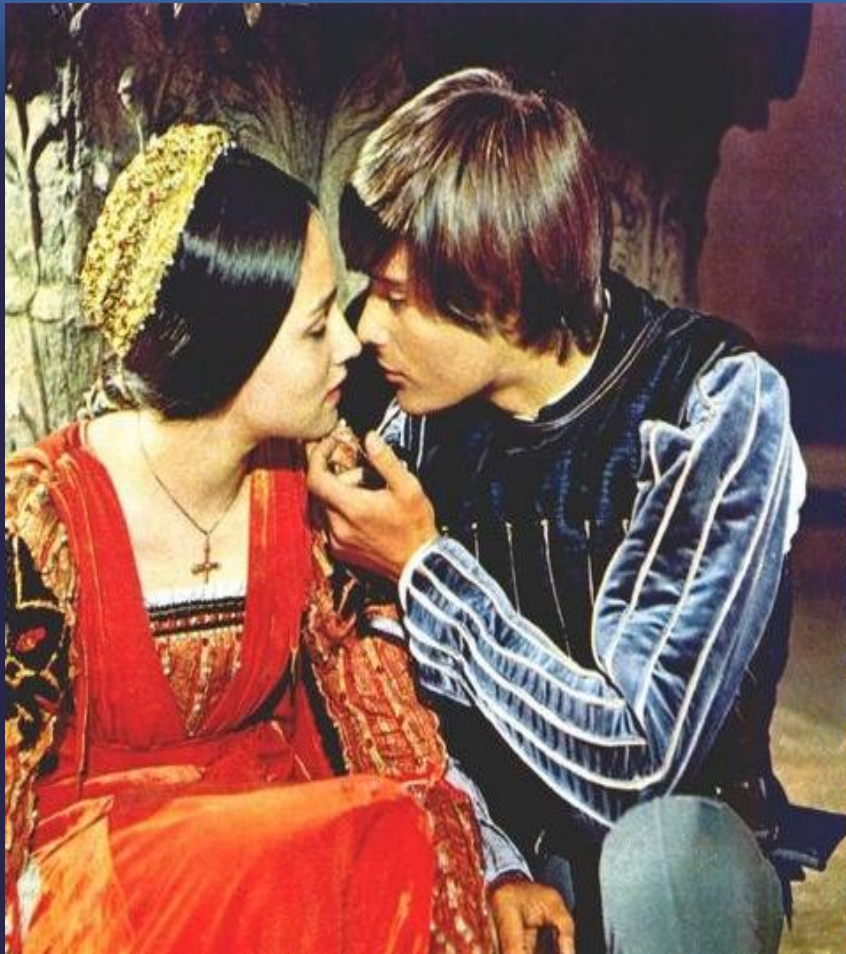


Romeo and Juliet(1594)
