


Bard of Avon



Birthplace of William Shakespeare William Shakespeare was born in Stratford-upon-Avon in 1564.




First Lost Years (1578-1578)

What work did he take up during that period? Options and views:


- He helped his father in the family business (leathers and grains)



Elizabethan era




Romeo and Juliet (1594)
