# Whose?-

Чей? Чья? Чье? Чьи?

- **Possessive Adjectives** (притяжательные местоимения);
- **Possessive Pronouns** (притяжательные местоимения)- абсолютная форма;
- **Possessive Case** (притяжательный падеж существительных)

# Possessive Case

(притяжательный падеж  
существительных)

- **Singular noun + ' S = sister's bag, dad's car**
- **Plural noun + ' = girls' books, twins' cousin**
- **Possessive Case (притяжательный падеж существительных) = Kate's friend, Mike's wife**
- **Translate: Bill's family, sisters' friends, Tom's grandson, twins' parents, grandma's house**

# Possessive Pronouns

## (притяжательные местоимения)

• my → mine

• his → his

• her → hers

• its → its

• our → ours

• your → yours

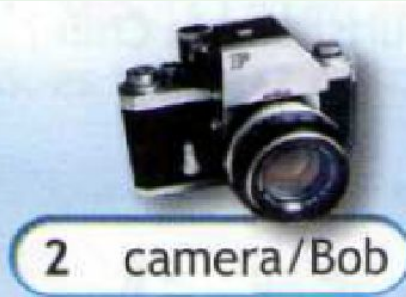
• their → theirs

e.g. This is **my** book.

It's **mine**. ❌

Possessive Case (притяжательны й падеж существительны х)	Possessive Adjectives (притяжательн ые местоимения)	Possessive Pronouns (притяжательные местоимения)- абсолютная форма
Bill's parents	His parents	The parents are his.
Kate and Kim's father	Their father	He is theirs.
twins' cousin	Your cousin	She is yours.
dog's toys	Its toys	The toys are its.
Mum's and my computer	Our computer	The computer is ours.
dad's car	My car	The car is mine.
