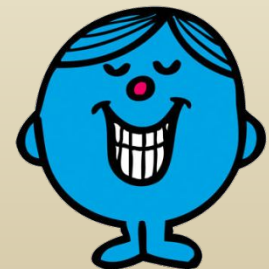

# 3 forms of the Verb

- Go, do, visit, clean,  
see, take, write, play,  
give, eat, put,  
translate, be, help,  
wash, open, meet,  
leave, live, sleep



## OPEN THE BRACKETS (present perfect)



1. Ann has gone to school. (go)
2. I have done my homework. (do)
3. Bill has seen Ann's pictures. (see)
4. Bill and I have taken our bicycles. (take)
5. The pupil has written a composition. (write)
6. The pupils have given their exercise-books to the teacher. (give)

8. Grandmother has put the vase on the table. (put)

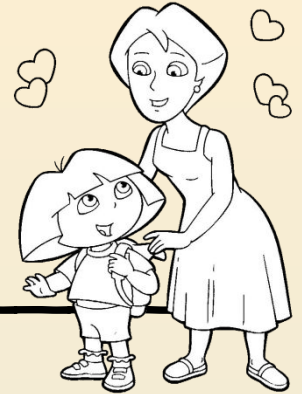
