I + am + verb(ing) He/she/it + is + verb(ing) They/we/you + are + verb(ing)

I am reading a book. He/she/it is watching TV. They/we/you are playing tennis.

I + am + not + verb(ing) He/she/it + isn't +verb (ing) They/we/you + aren't + verb(ing)

I am not reading a book. He/she/it isn't watching TV. They/we/you aren't playing tennis.

Are + they/we/you + verb(ing)? Is + he/she/it + verb(ing)? Am + I + verb(ing)?

Am I reading a book?
Is he/she/it watching TV?
Are they/you/we playing tennis?

* Things that will change.


* Describing a current action.

actions and things that are happening now





Present Continuous (to be +Ving)

function	example
Действие происходящее в момент говорения	I am cooking dinner now.
Временные ситуации	We are fixing the car this weekend.
Договоренности на ближайшее будущее	I am seeing Kate tonight.
Изменяющиеся или развивающиеся ситуации	The temperature is becoming warmer and warmer.
Выражение гнева, раздражения	She is always taking my things!

<u>Times expressions:</u> now, at the moment, at present, these day nowadays, still, today, tonight
