I was hardly me.

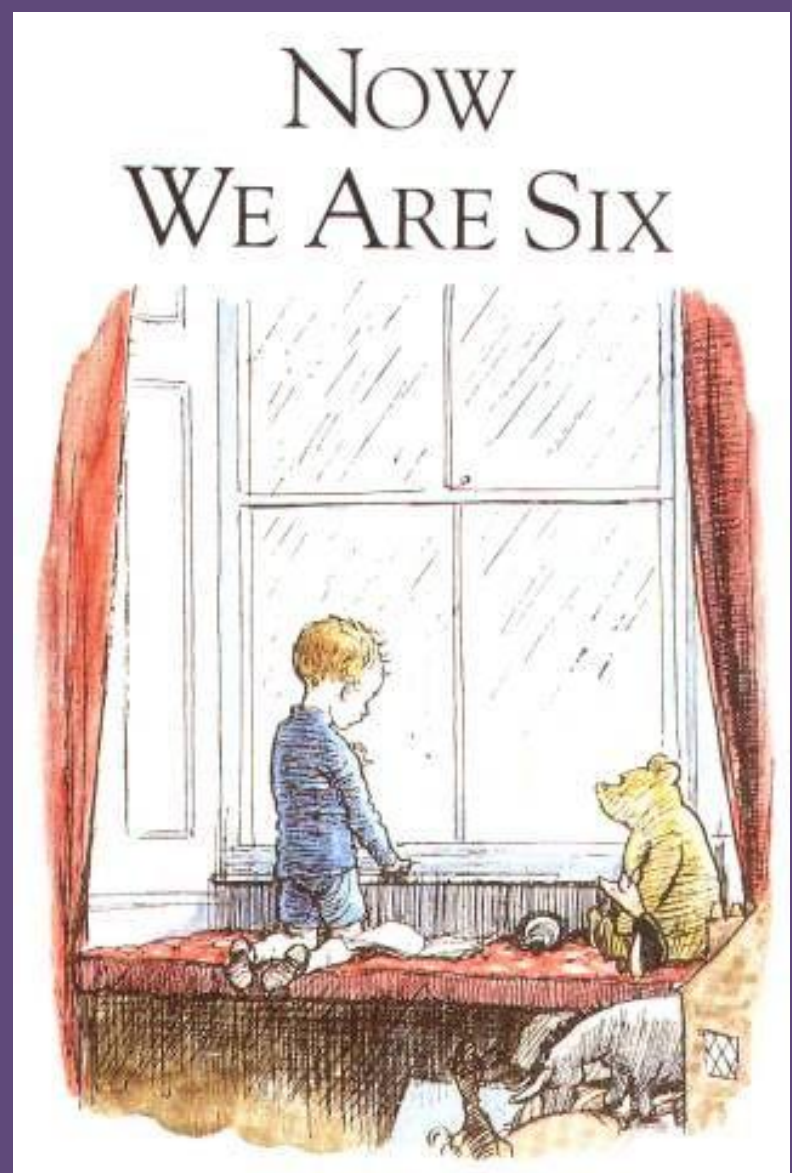
When I was Four,

and I see ME!

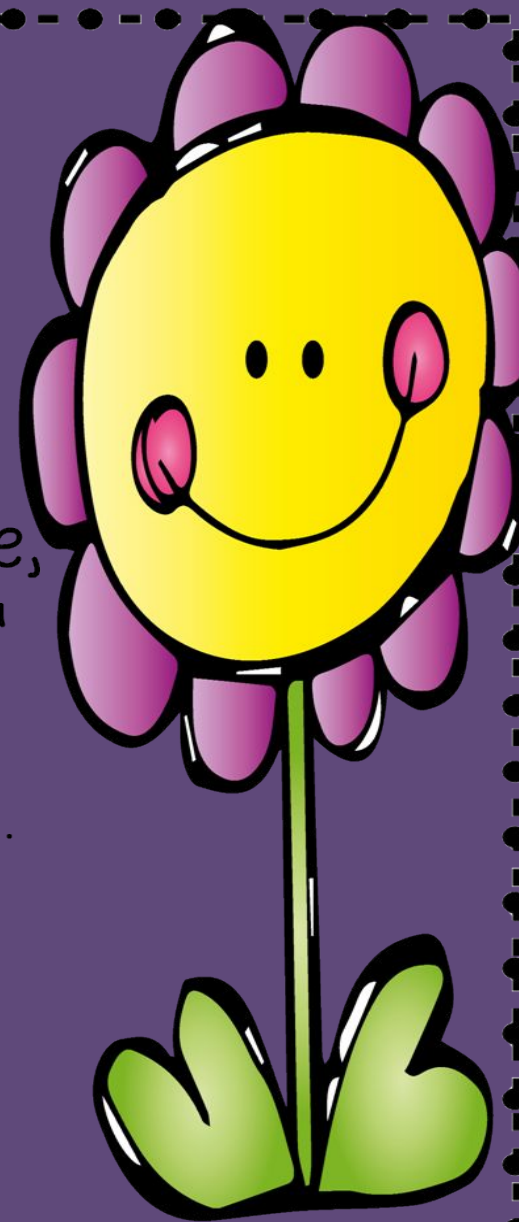
The Little Plant

He caught that mosquito

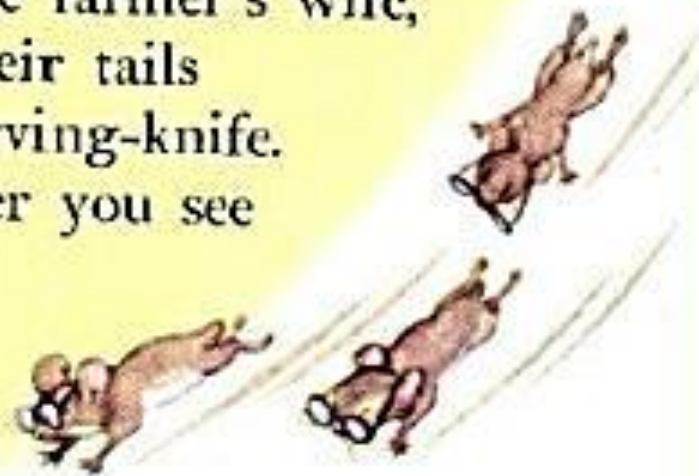
He caught that flea

And I will roar some more!






Little Fish
