- *How would you feel if one of your parents was famous?*

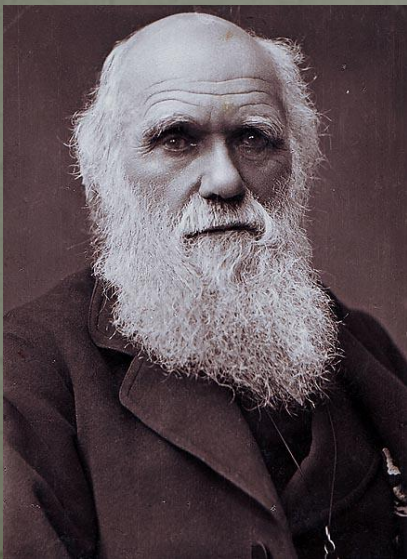

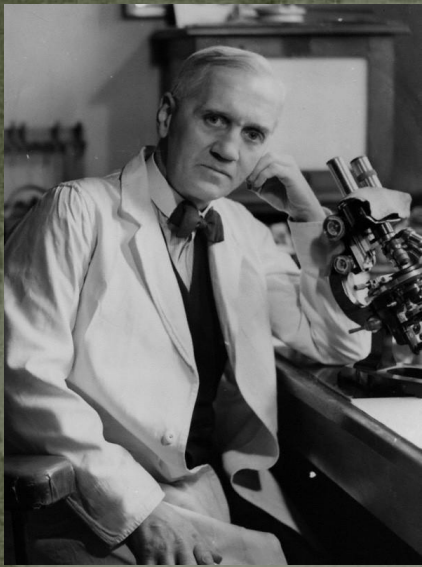
William Shakespeare is a prominent British poet, the greatest dramatist of all time.



Isambard Kingdom Brunel is a constructor of the first major British railway.

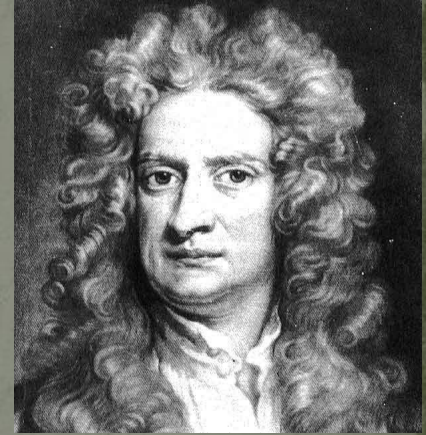


Charles Darwin is a well-known naturalist and the father of a scientific theory of natural selection.

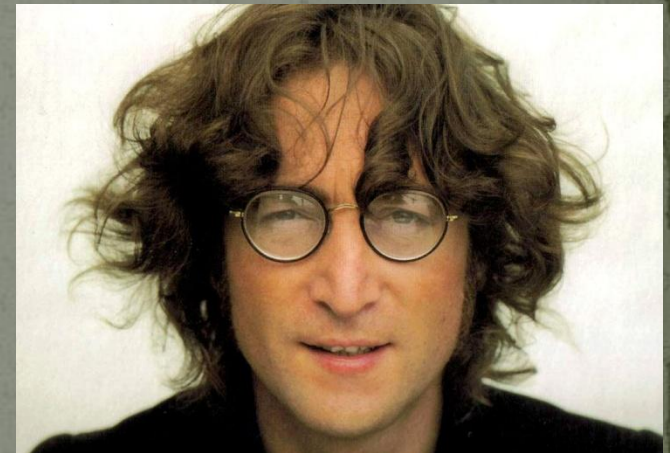


Alexander Fleming is a Scottish biologist and pharmacologist.

John Lennon is a noticeable British musician, a member of the Beatles Band.

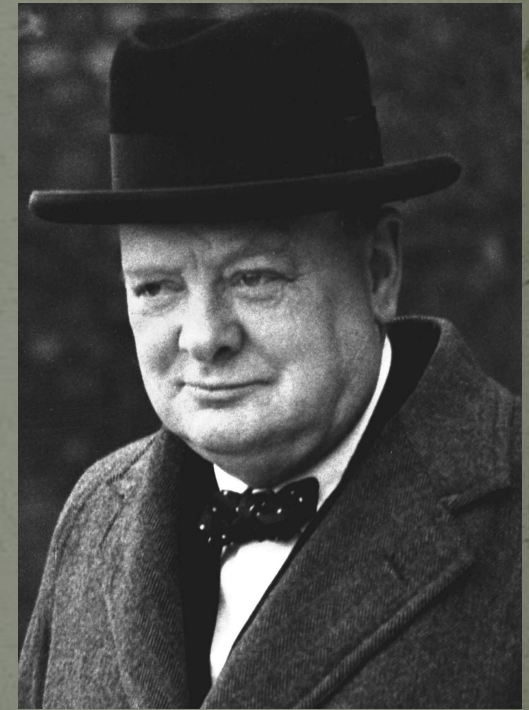


Captain James Cook is a noted British sailor who achieved the first European contact with the eastern coastline of Australia.
