1. **play (v)** - to perform the actions and say the words of a character in a theatre performance

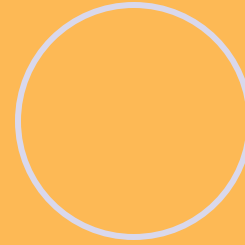
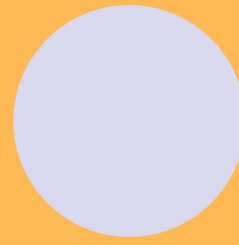
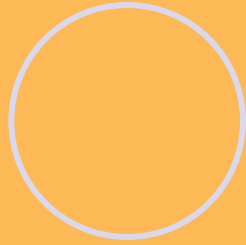
Note: play+object,

e.g. play a role, He has always wanted to play Hamlet.

play (n) - a piece of dramatic writing performed in a theatre

e.g. 'Romeo and Juliet' is the best-known play by William Shakespeare.





2. act (v) – to perform, especially on the stage

Note: act needs no object.

e.g. *Hopkins is acting tonight.*

act (n) – one of the main parts of a play

3. stage (v) – to produce a play

e.g. *The school drama group stages two plays every year.*

stage (n) – the raised floor in a theatre on which plays are performed


e.g. *At the end of the performance all the actors came out onto the stage.*

George Bernard Shaw was born in Dublin in 1856. At the age of 19 he moved to London. Bernard Shaw wanted to become a novelist. However his novels were not successful and he gave up writing them.
