A long time ago, the Pilgrims lived in England.

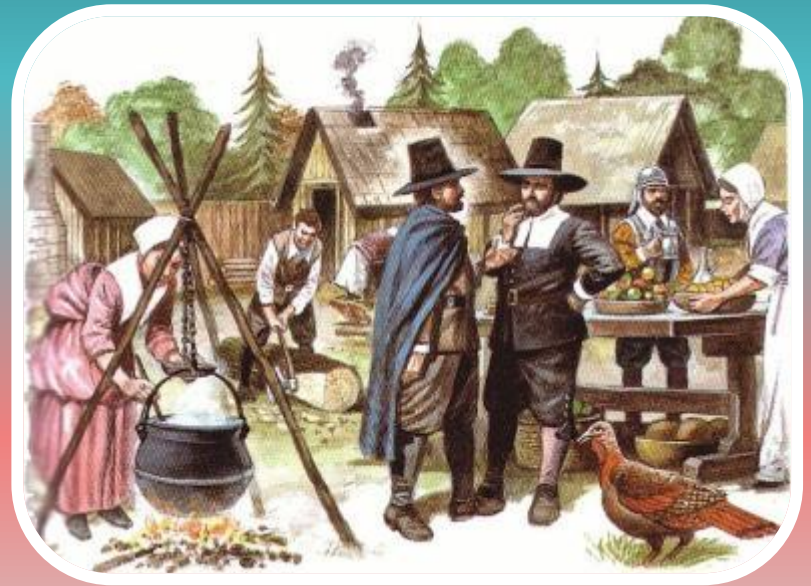

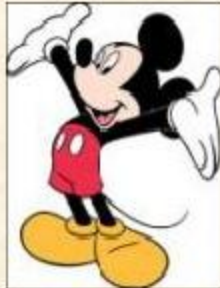
