He *always* delivers letters.

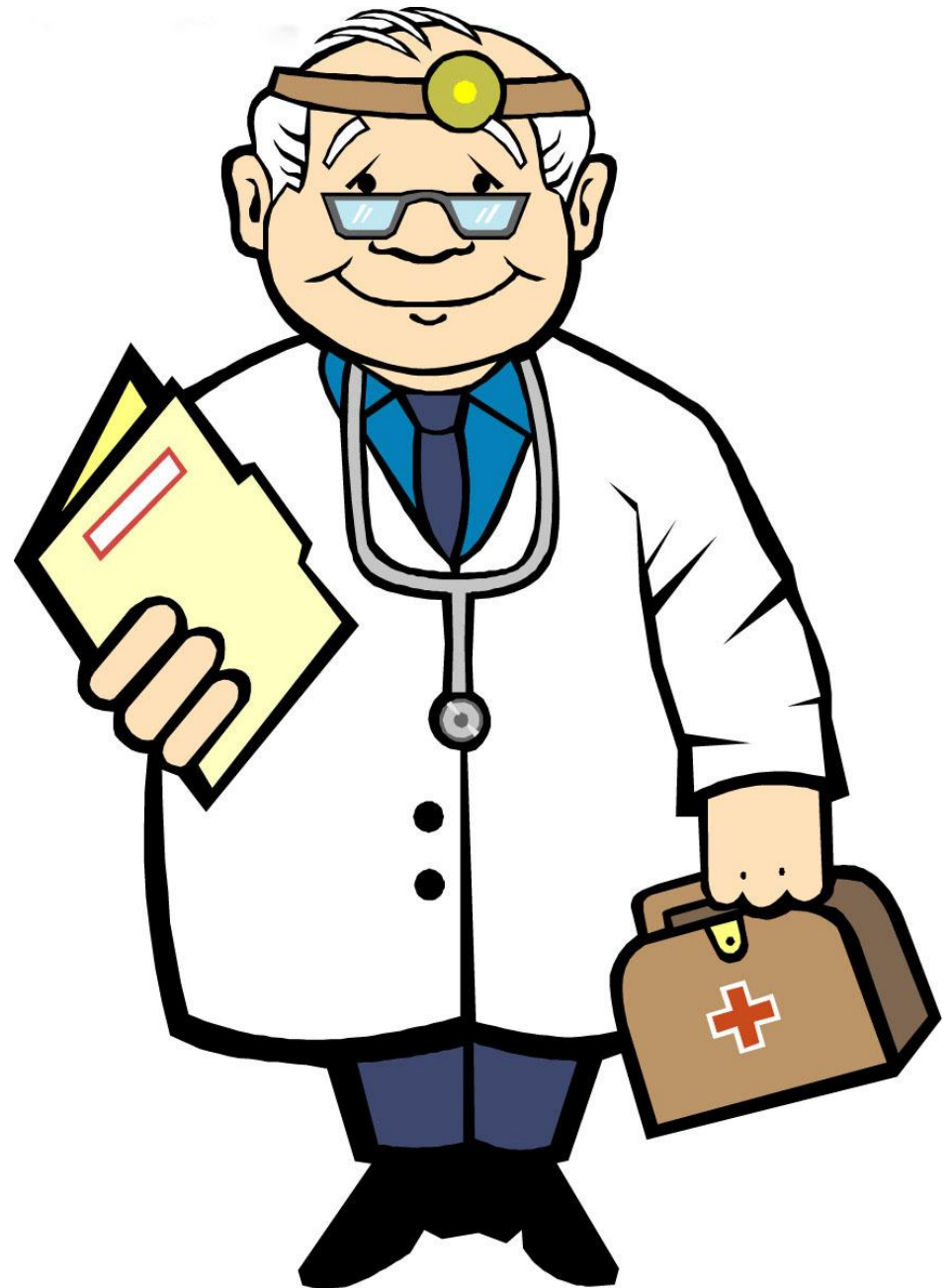
And he **is** delivering a letter *now*.

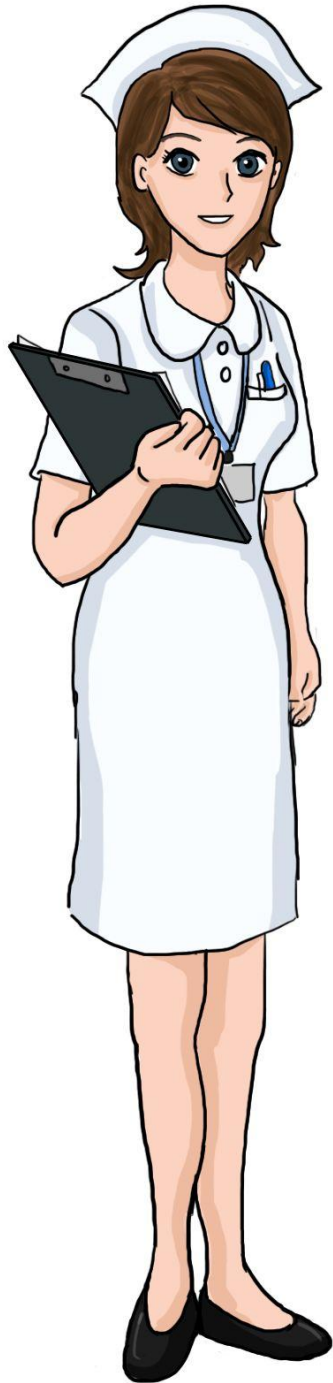


He **is** a

She **is not** a doctor

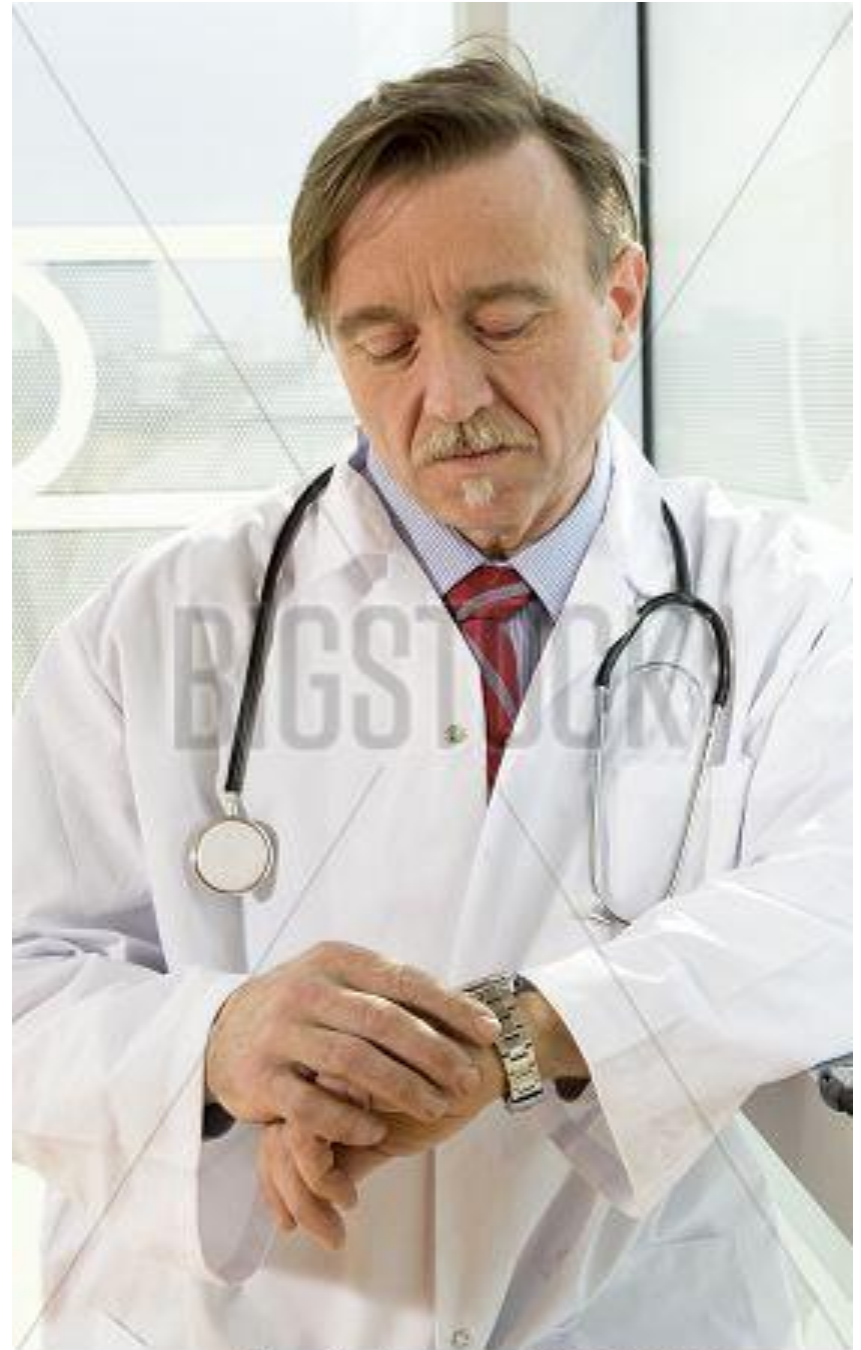
she **is** a nurse

Ambulance



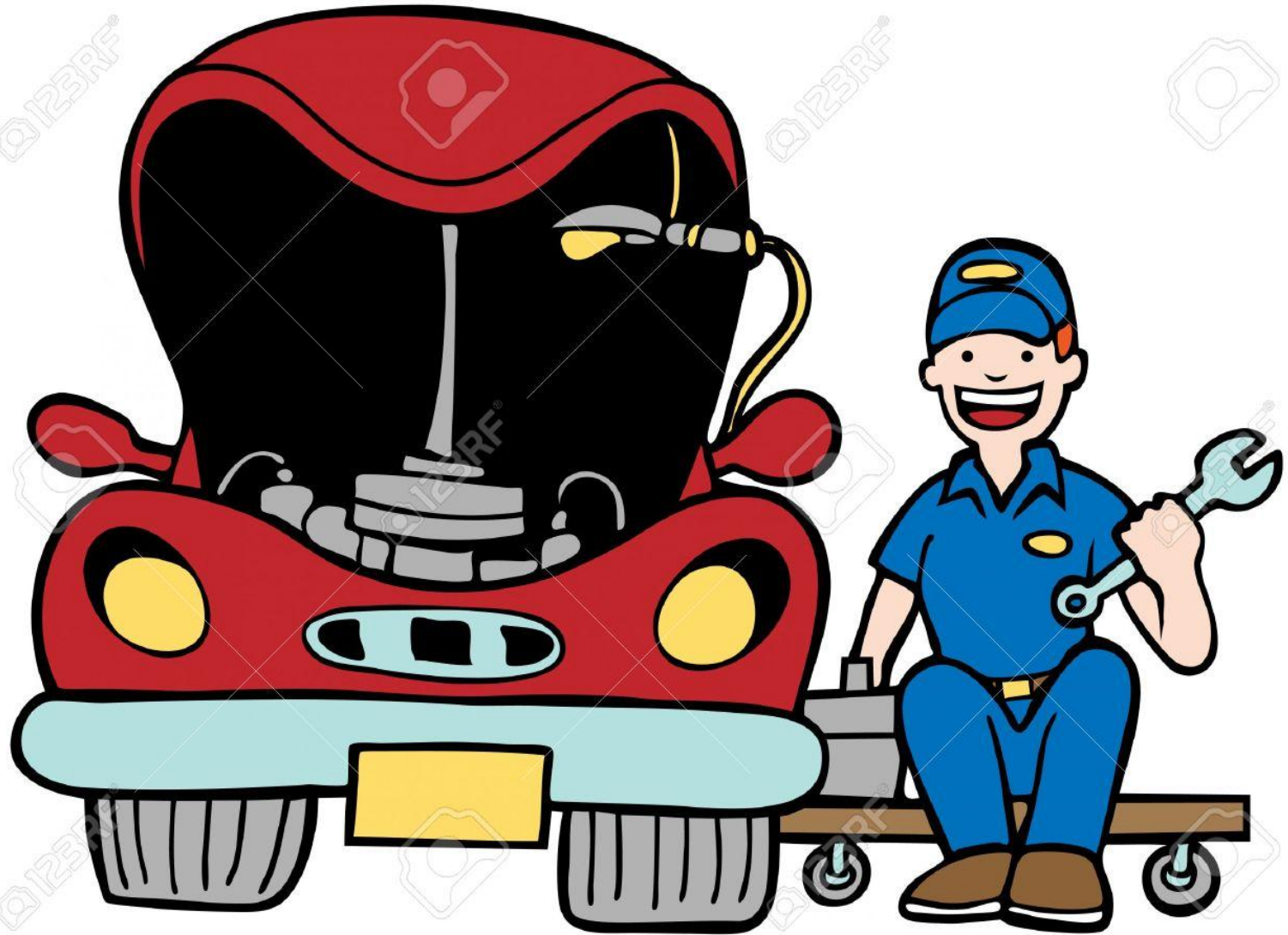


He **is** a

food

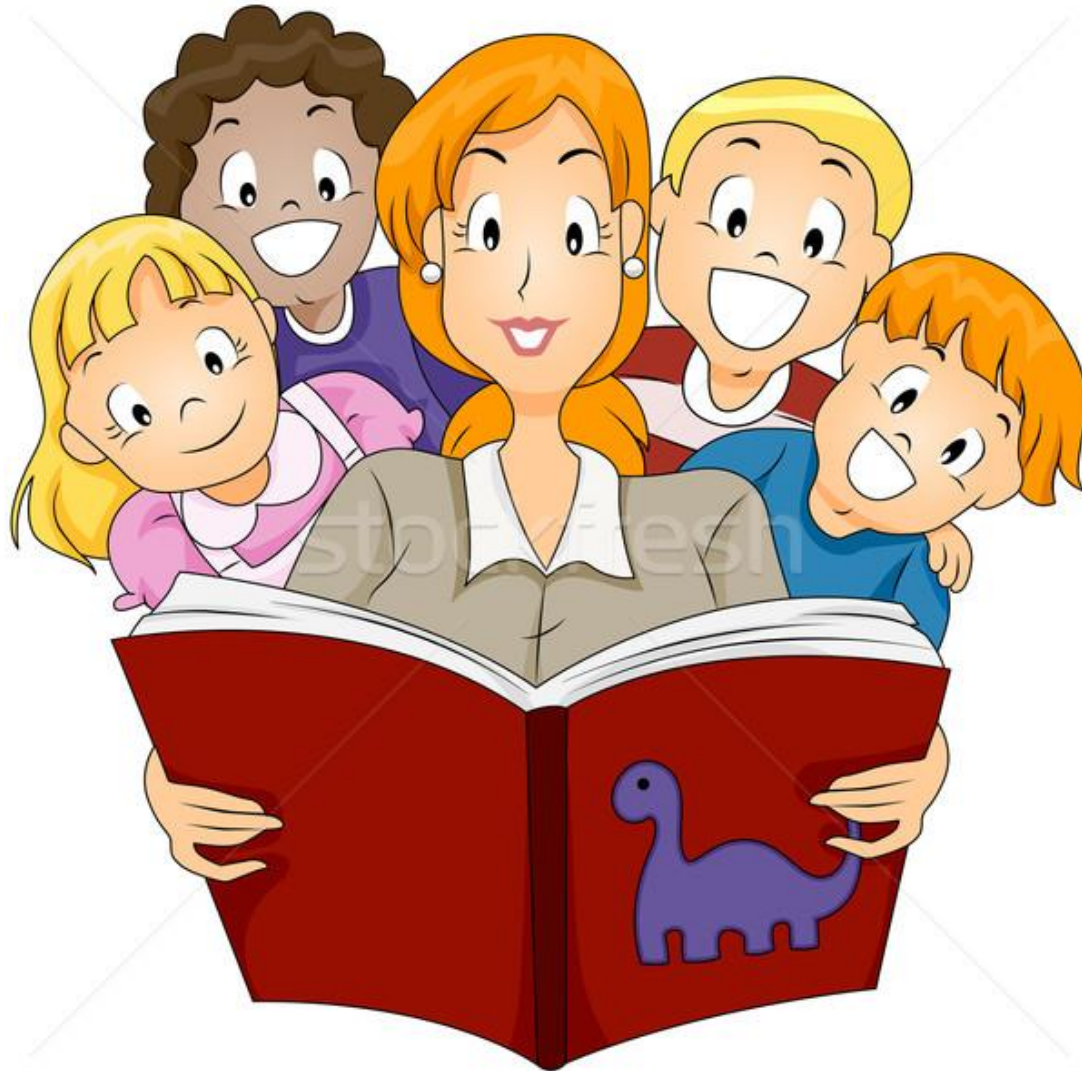
She **is** serving
