It attracts a lot of tourists.**

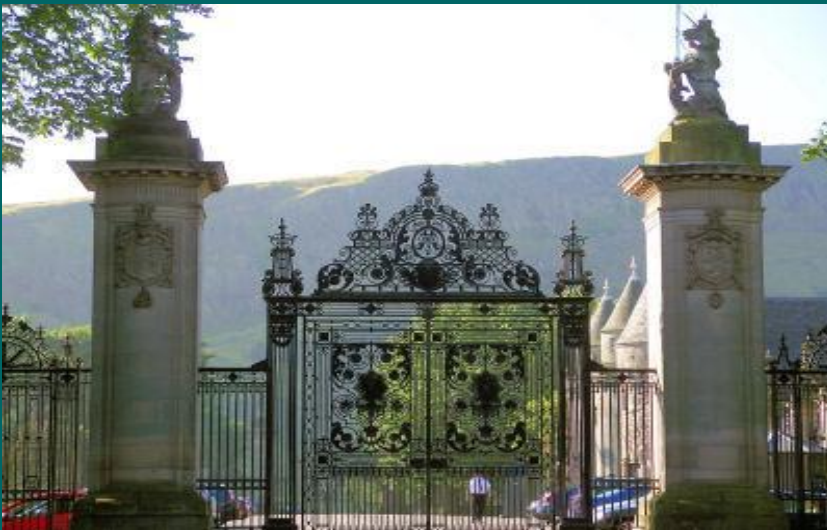

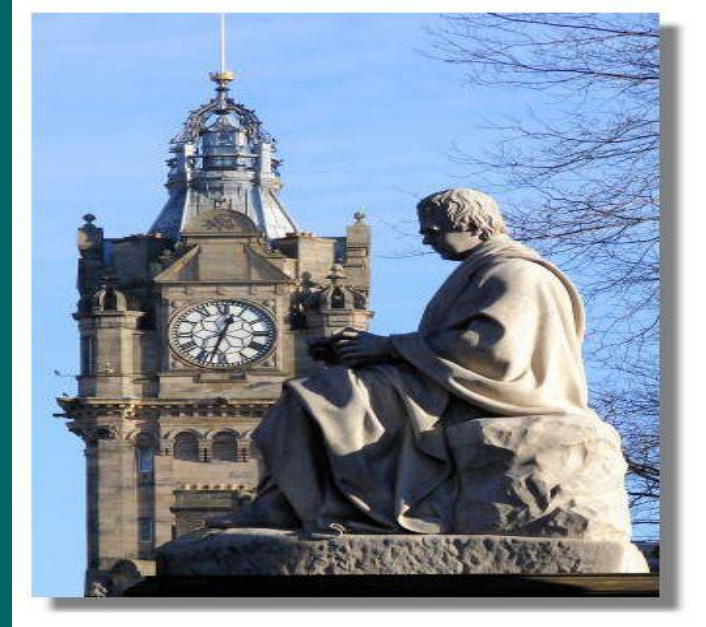
One of the best known monuments is a monument to a dog called Bobby. His statue is a symbol of devotion.
