




a country in the United Kingdom to to the north of England.

Glasgow is its largest and busiest town, Edinburgh is its capital.






The most interesting parts of the city are the Old Town and the New Town

Holyrood House (the Old Town)




a big royal palace

the Royal Mile (The Old Town)




A line of streets, which runs from The Castle to Holyrood House

Cannongate (the Old Town)






The most picturesque part of the Royal Mile

the most beautiful street of the New Town


