Dmitry: *Yes, I was.*

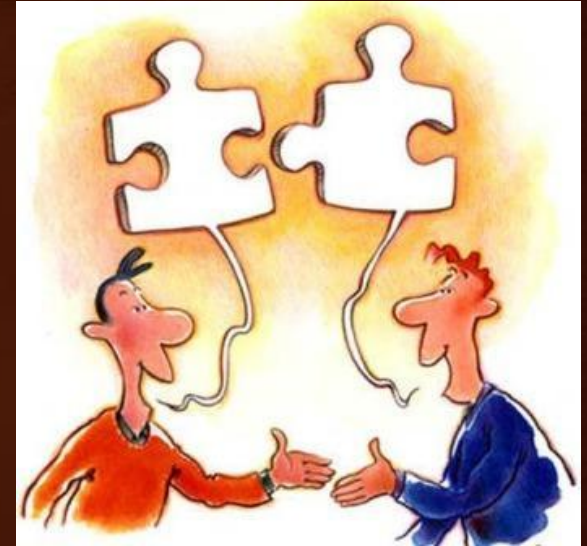
Carol: *Was it good?*
