CITY

- London is the biggest city in Britain. More than seven million people live and work there.

BUCKINGHAM PALACE

- The Queen of England lives in Buckingham Palace. It is a wonderful building with a monument in front of it which is the Queen Victoria Memorial.



BIG BEN



- The large clock on one of the towers is Big Ben. You can hear the sound of Big Ben every hour in London.

HYDE PARK

- The largest park in London is Hyde park. It one of the most popular places for Londoners on hot summer days.



TRAFALGAR SQUARE

- The centre of London is Trafalgar Square. In the middle of the square stands a tall column. It is a monument to Admiral Nelson.



HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT

- A long grey building with towers are the Houses of Parliament.



WESTMINSTER ABBEY

- Westminster Abbey is one of the greatest churches in London. It is more than nine hundred years old. Many English kings and queens are buried there. Westminster Abbey is famous for the Poet`s Corner too.



ST JAMES' PARK

- St. James's Park is a 23 hectare park in the City of Westminster, central London - the oldest of the Royal Parks of London.
