Teachers' answers (yes 100%)

How often do you use SMS?

Students' answers (constantly 60%; often 35%; seldom 5%)

Teachers' answers (constantly 20%; often 50%; seldom 30%)

Why do you use SMS?

Students' answers (comfortably 65%, saving money 33%, I don't want to meet face to face 2%)

Teachers' answers (comfortably 30%, quickly 20%, saving money 50%)

100% of students and teachers use SMS

Students use SMS more often than teachers

Students use SMS because it is comfortable

Teachers and students use SMS to save money

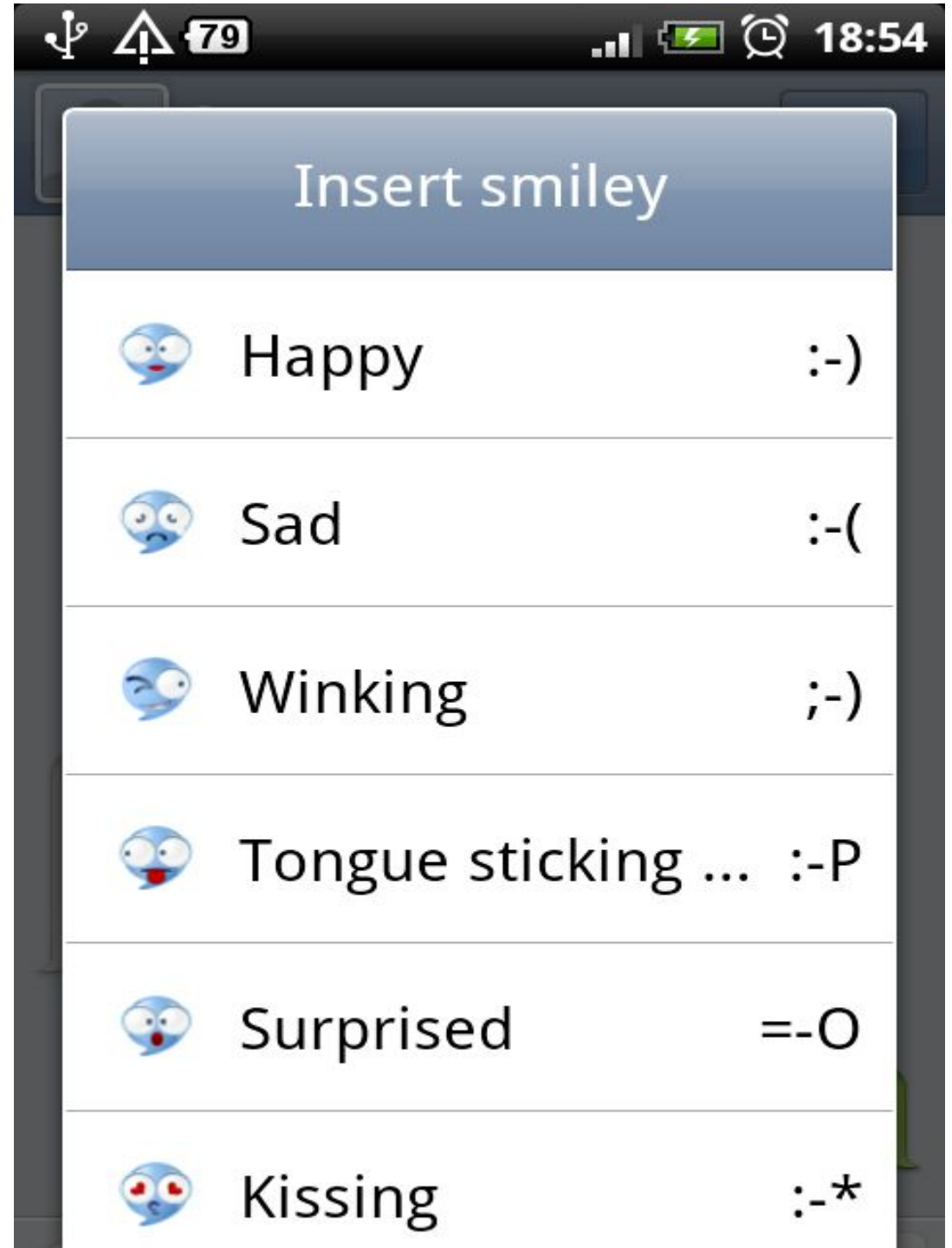

- **Lexical (abbreviations, reduction, transliteration)**
- in Russian Куда бы сматаца ???(смотреться)
- in English C u tomorrow - See you tomorrow, luv u - I love you.
- **There are no commas, full stops or there are a lot of dots, question marks, exclamation marks.**
- in Russian- Ты де?????????????
- in English -Hi where are - hi, where are you?
- **Missing prepositions, auxiliary verbs (in English), and wrong sentence constructions.**
- in Russian- Поздравляю праздником!!!!!!
- in English Free to talk? - Are you free to talk?
