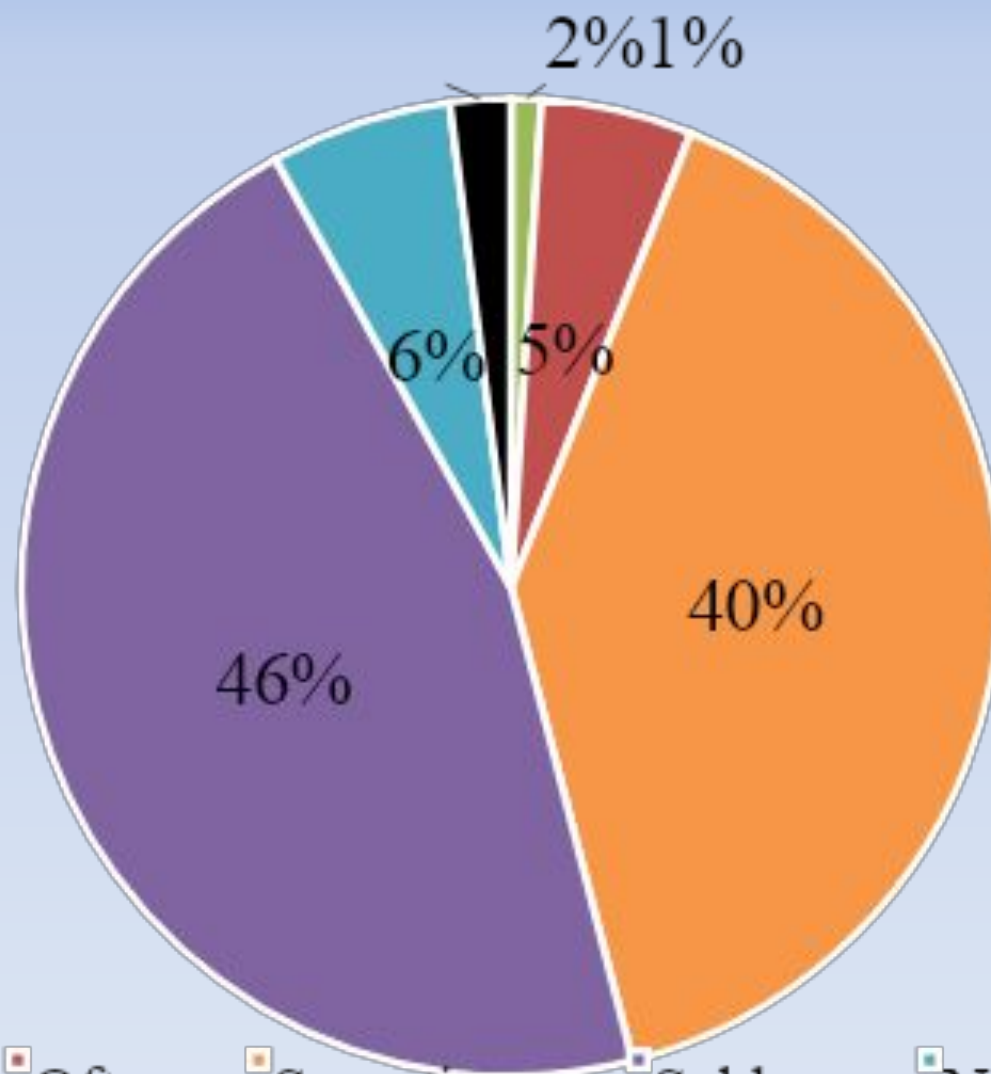

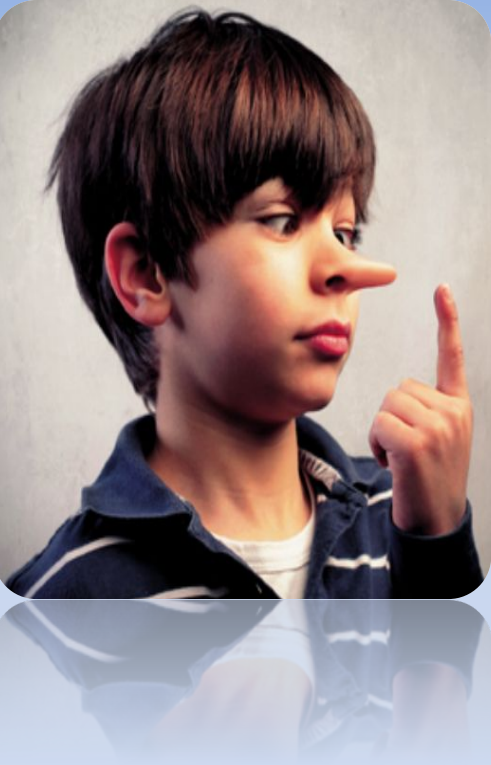


CHILDREN'S ANSWERS (10 – 12 YEARS)

1st place - Being sick (75%)

2nd place - Telling someone that you're listening when you aren't (25%)

3d place - Being "five minute away" (5%)



TEEN'S ANSWERS (13 – 18 YEARS)

1st place - Being “five minute away” (43%)

2nd place - Liking someone's clothes (40%)

3d place - Seeing a movie you haven't actually seen (17%)



ADULT'S ANSWERS (20 – ... YEARS)

1st place – (The biggest lie we tell ourselves)

“I don’t need to write that down, I’ll remember it!”(79%)

2nd place - Being “five minute away” (12%)

3d place - Liking someone’s cooking (9%)
