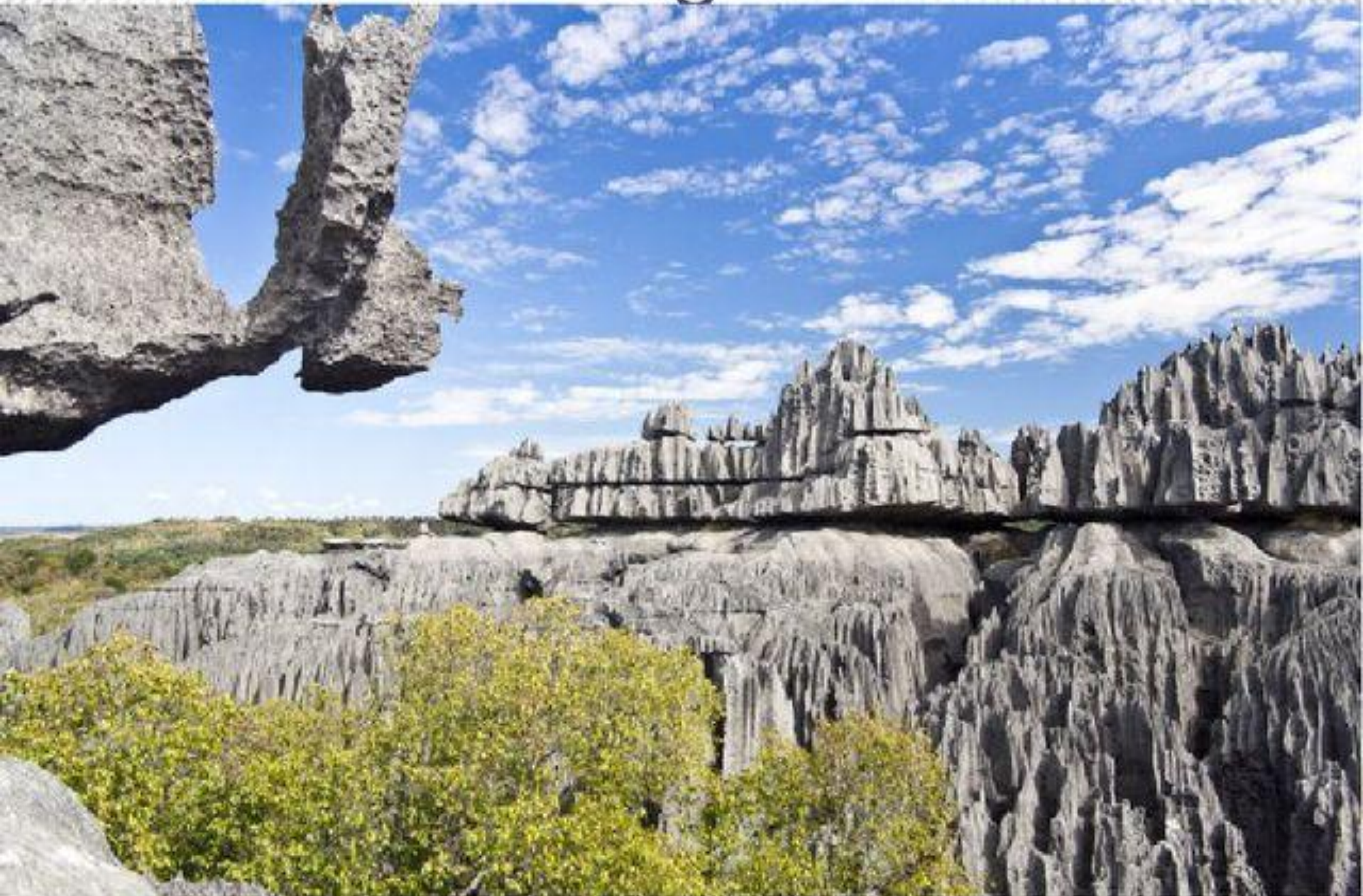

Madagascar is home to 258 bird species of which 115 are found nowhere else in the world.
