



#### Childhood


Mikhail Lomonosov was born on November, 19 in 1711 in Denisovka village (Arkhangelsk province)

#### To Moscow


- ☐ At the age of 19 Mikhail decides to escape to Moscow
- ☐ He comes to Moscow in 1731
- ☐ Had to be called "a noble son" in Moscow



#### Entered the Slavonic-Greek-La tin Academy

- There was no money and the help could come from nowhere
- Mikhail managed to go all 12-year course of study for 5 years

#### Study in Germany

- in 1736 goes to study to Germany;
- studies technical and natural sciences as well as foreign languages and literature;
- collects his own library;
- puts the experiments and gives lectures;
- composes poems;
- in 1741 Mikhail Vasilyevich returned to his homeland.

In 1742 Lomonosov was appointed as an adjunct of physics at the St. Petersburg Academy of Sciences. At the age of 34 Mikhail Vasilyevich became a Professor of chemistry.

#### Lomonosov – scientist - encyclopedist



- Made a great contribution to the development of both technical and humanity sciences.
- the founder of the development of such sciences in Russia as chemistry, geology, metallurgy.
- studied the history of Russian people, the arts of poetry and Russian language.




Designed a new device –
