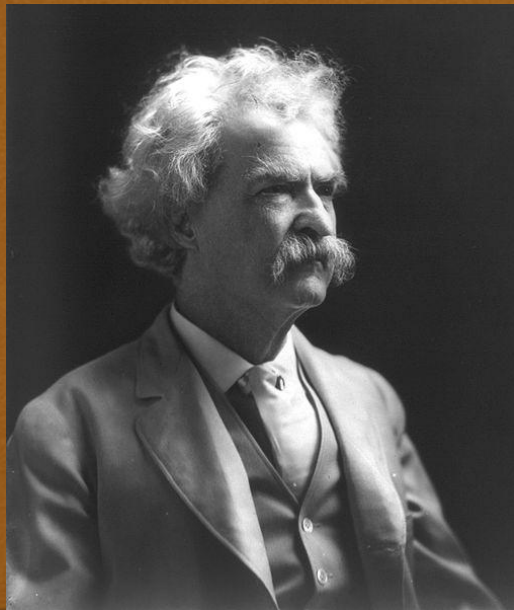


Mark Twain

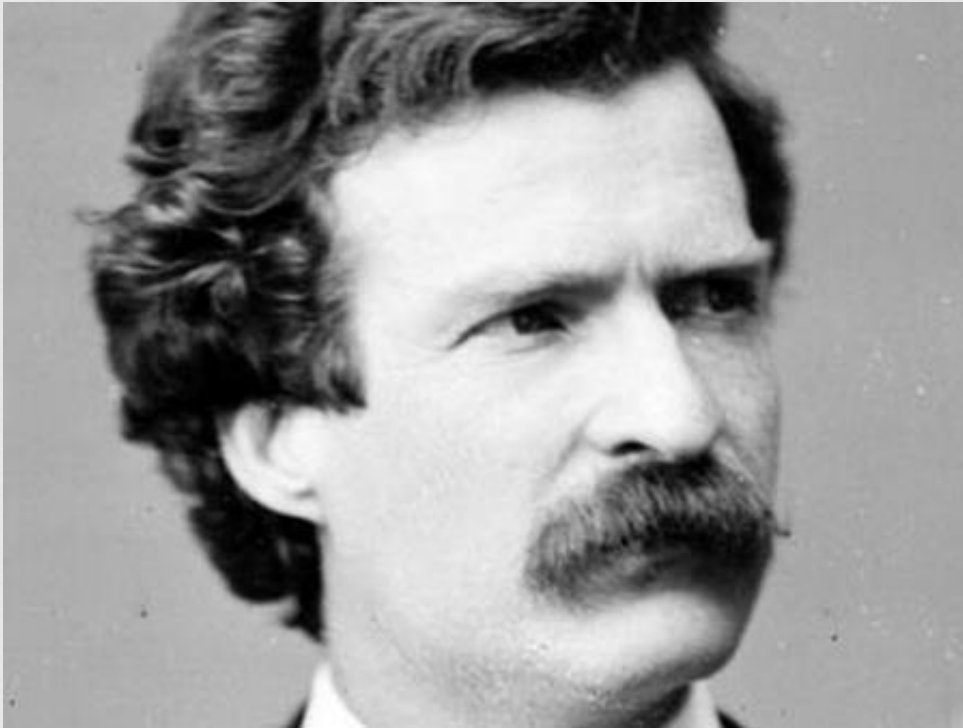

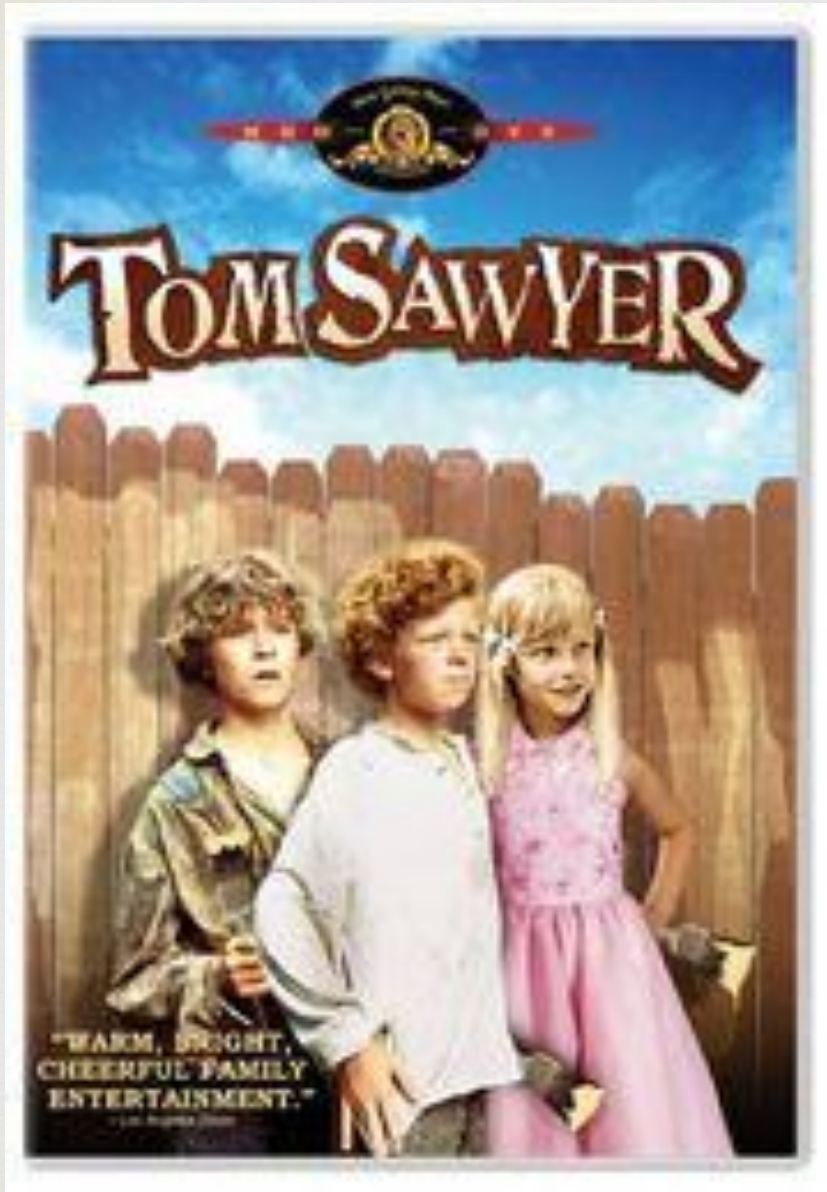


In 1847, when Sam was 11, his father died. He left school and began to work as a printer's apprentice for a newspaper. His job allowed Sam to read the news of the world.

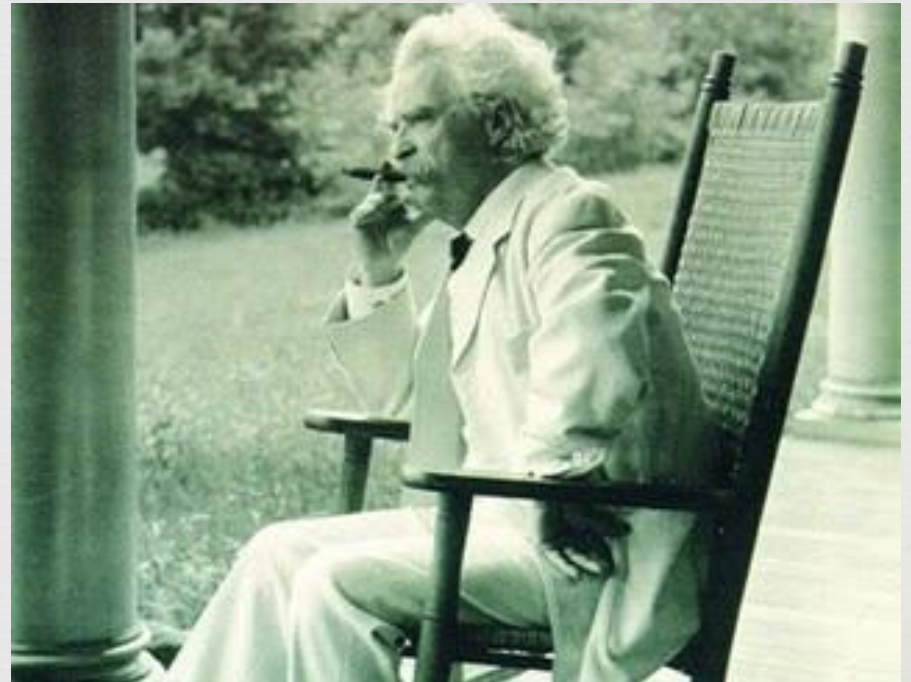
Literary career
