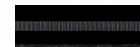

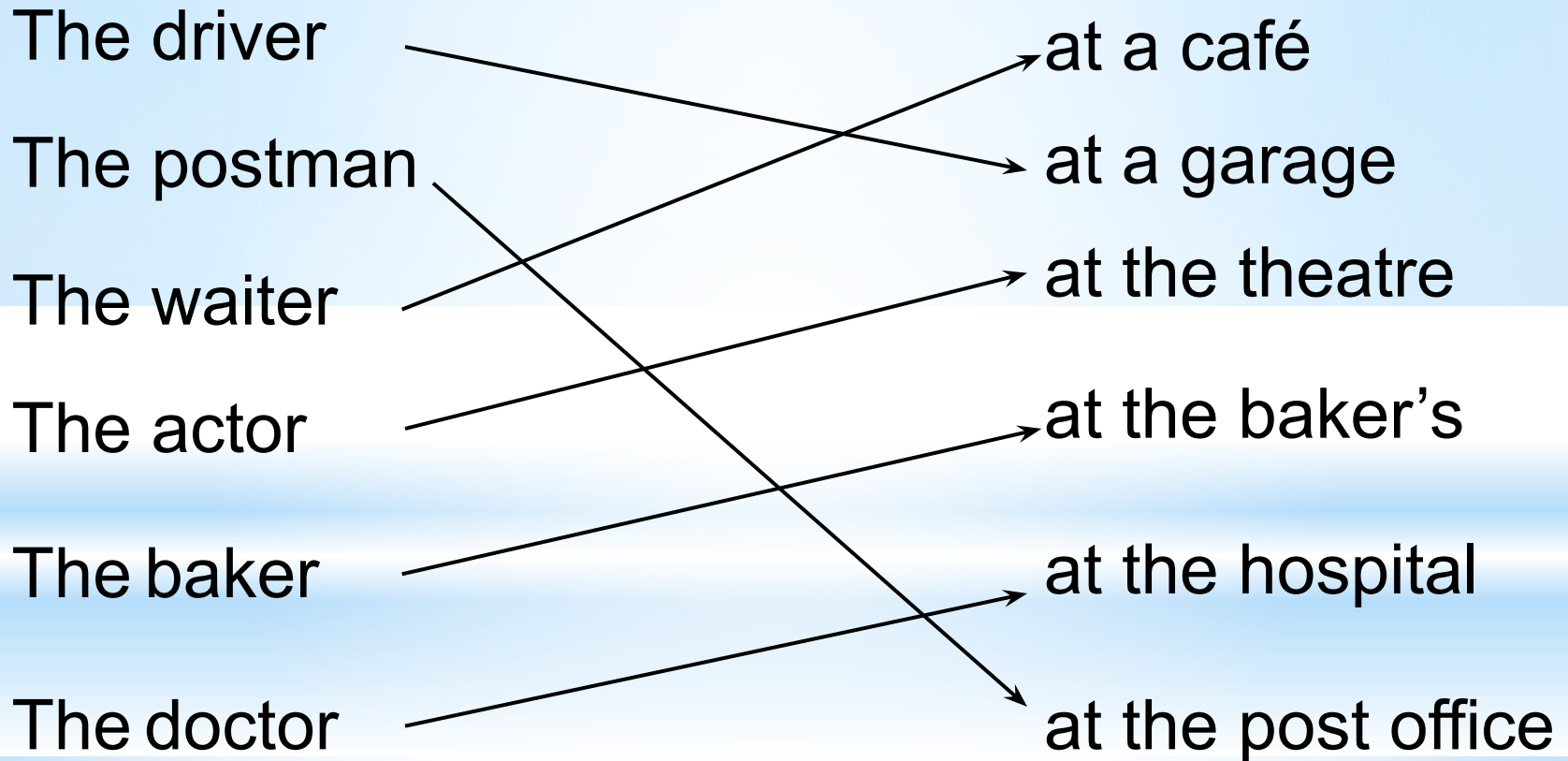

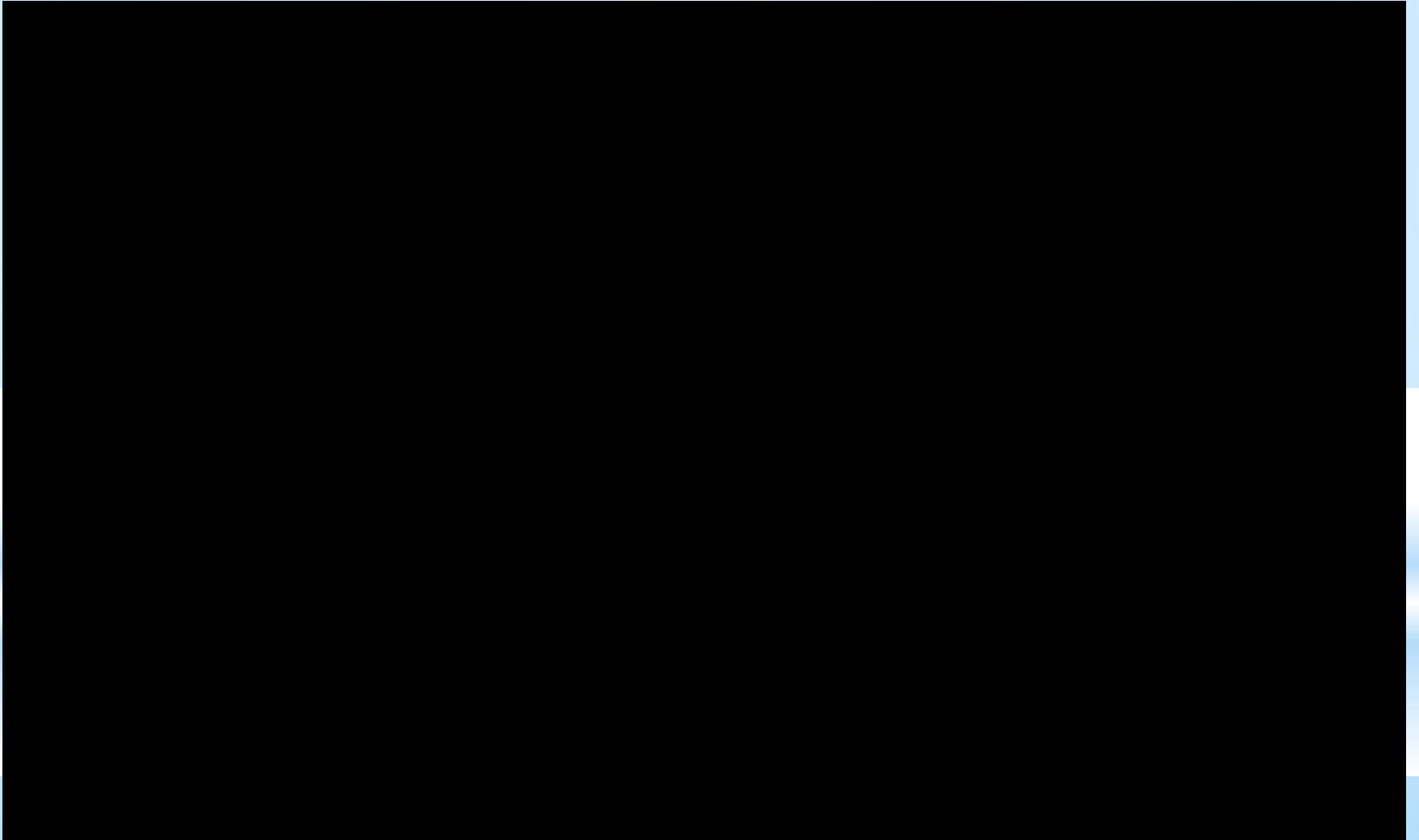


# Find some mistakes in the verbs
