Famous women



Princess Diana(1961-1997)

- Princess of Wales, married to prince Charles, later divorced. Known for her humanitarian and charity work.
- she died in a car crash in Paris in 1997



Margaret Thatcher(1925-2013)

- the first female Prime Minister in Britain.
- She was one of the dominant political figures of the 20th century Britain.



Indira Gandhi(1917-1984)

- India's first female Prime Minister.
- In 1999 she was voted the greatest woman of the past thousand years in a poll carried by BBC news.



Mother Teresa (1910-1997)

- A Roman Catholic nun and charity worker, who devoted her life to serving poor.
- Her famous words: "It is not how much we do, but how much love we put in the doing. It is not how much we give, but how much love we put in the giving."



Ann Frank (1929-1945)_

- A Jewish diarist who documented her life hiding in an Amsterdam attic.
- Her diaries has become an important symbol of how innocent people can suffer from intolerance and persecution.



Rosa Parks (1913-2005)

- An African-American Civil Right activist.
- the United States Congress called her “The mother of the freedom movement”.



Hillary Clinton (1947_)

- US Secretary of State 2009-2013.
- First lady during Bill Clinton's presidency and democratic candidate for President in 2008.



Valentina Tereskova(1937_)

- The first Russian woman in space.
- selected from more than four hundred applicants and five finalists to pilot Vostok 6 on 16 June 1963.



Audrey Hepburn(1929-1993)

- Actress, greatest female screen legend of all time.
- Fashion icon and humanitarian who worked for Unicef.

Coco Chanel (1883-1971)

- Leading French Fashion designer and founder of fashion label Chanel.
- **Her Famous words:**
“ Fashion is not something that exists in dresses only. Fashion is in the sky, in the street, fashion has to do with ideas, the way we live, what is happening.”



Queen Elizabeth II (1926-)

- Elizabeth Alexandra Mary is the constitutional monarch of 16 sovereign states.
- She carries the additional title of “Defender of the Faith”.



Maria Callas (1923-1977)

- An American- born Greek soprano and one of the influential opera singers of the 20th century.
- She made an early impression as a child singer and soon she was performing in major houses in Europe and US.
