Now a lot of people in England eat sandwiches for their lunch.

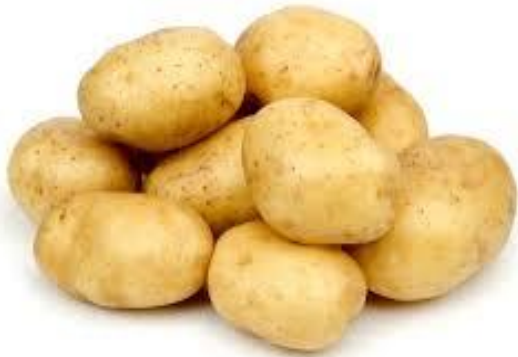

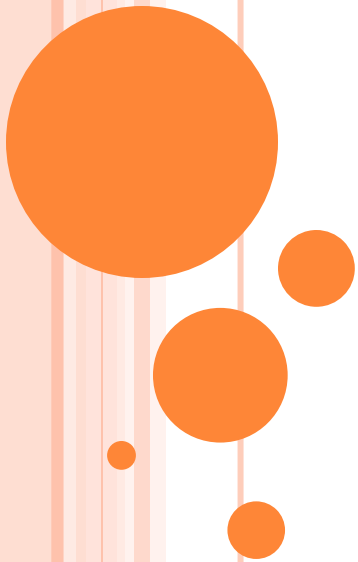

made of-

используется, когда исходный продукт остаётся неизменным.

Example: *A sandwich is made of cheese, sausage and bread.*

made from-

используется, когда исходный продукт полностью видоизменяется.

Example: *Juice is made from apples, oranges.*

Ice cream is made of/ from milk, sugar.

A pizza is made of/ from sausage, tomatoes, and mushrooms.

Omelet is made of/ from eggs and milk.

Salad is made of / from tomatoes, cucumbers.

A hamburger is made of /from bread, cheese and sausage.

Yoghurt is made of/ from milk, fruit and sugar.



Juice is made of/from apples.

A fruit sandwich is made of / from bread, cottage cheese and fruits.

Cheese is made of/ from milk.

Fruit salad is made of / from apples, bananas, oranges and strawberries.
