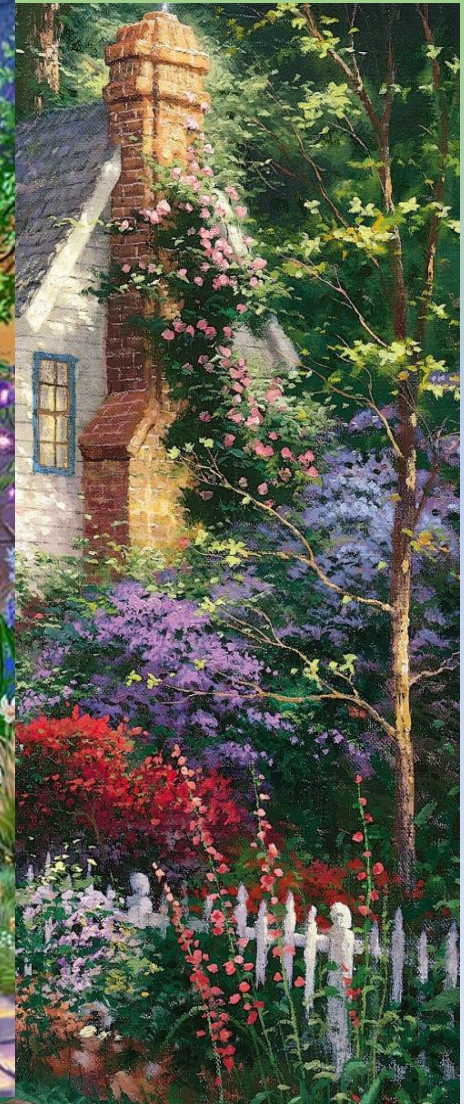
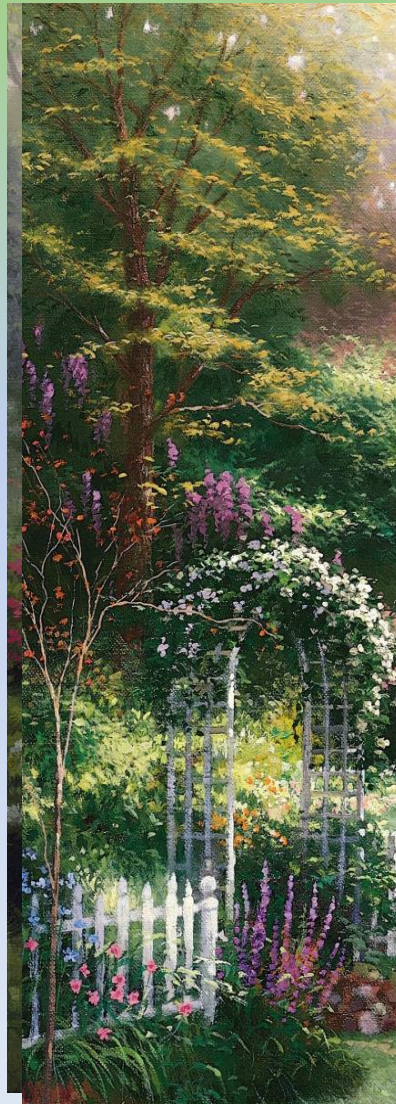


The fire is the focus of the English Home. The fireplace is **the centre of interest** in the room. They like to **sit round the fire** and watch the dancing flames, talking.
