# The Present Perfect Tense

I **have opened** the window.

- He **has opened** the window.
- She **has opened** the window.
- We **have opened** the window.
- You **have opened** the window.
- They **have opened** the window.

# The Present Perfect Tense

- I **have not locked** the door.
- I **haven't locked** the door.
- He **has not locked** the door.
- He **hasn't locked** the door.
- We **have not locked** the door.
- We **haven't locked** the door.

# The Present Perfect Tense

- **Have** you **opened** the window?
- Yes, I **have**.
- No, I **haven't**.
- **Has** he **opened** the window?
- Yes, he **has**.
- No, he **hasn't**.
- **Have** they **opened** the window?
- Yes, they **have**.
- No, they **haven't**.

# Tense

- Have you been to the Kremlin **yet**?
- Yes, I have **already** been to the Kremlin.
- No, I haven't been to the Kremlin **yet**.

- Have you bought a new picture **yet**?
- Yes, I have.
- I have **already** bought it.
- No, I haven't.
- I haven't bought it **yet**.

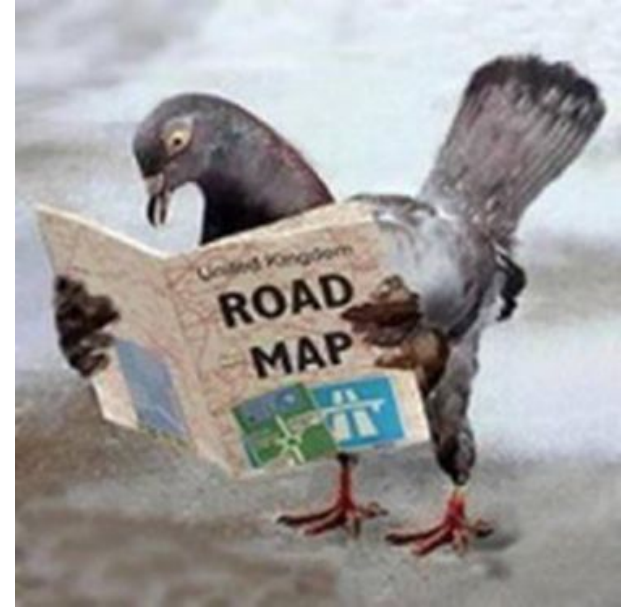

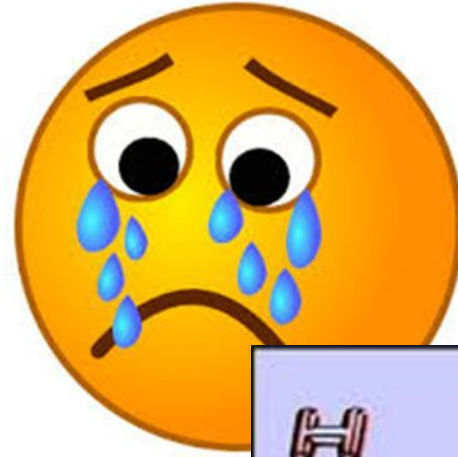
